DIRECTIONS FOR USE

May be applied with airplane or ground application equipment.
ON CHERRIES to control Cherry Fruit Fly, Brown Rot and Leaf Spot. Use at the rate of 50-60 pounds per acre. Apply when blossoms first emerge and repeat at weekly intervals. For disease control this material must be applied before the disease appears. Do not apply within 2 days of harvest. Do not graze treated forage by livestock.

ON APPLES and PEARS for the control of Codling Moth, Apple and Pear Scab and Powdery Mildew use at the rate of 50-60 pounds per acre. Use in petal fall and cover application. Do not apply within 30 days of harvest. If additional scab and mildew control is required beyond the use limit of this product, use a suitable fungicide. Remove excess red wax at time of harvest. Do not graze treated forage by livestock.
