DIRECTIONS FOR USE

NOT FOR USE OR STORAGE IN OR AROUND THE HOME

Apply in sufficient water for thorough coverage when insects or mites first appear in threatening numbers and repeat as required to maintain effective control. Spray plants thoroughly, making a special effort to treat the undersides of the leaves. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest on edible crops. Do not use in undiluted form.

When applying this material by aircraft, mix the recommended amount with sufficient water to provide a minimum of 3 to 10 gallons of finished spray per acre.

APPLES: Rosy and Green Apple Aphids, European Red and Two-Spotted Mites - Use 1/4 to 1/3 pint per 100 gals. of water.

PEACHES: European Red and Two-Spotted Mites - Use 1/4 to 1/3 pint per 100 gals.

APPLES, PEACHES: Locust (periodical cicada) - Use 1/4 pint per 100 gallons of water.

CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER, POTATOES: Aphids - Use 1/2 to 2/3 pint per acre.

USAGE NOTE - This material is usually considered to be most effective when used alone in special applications. It is, however, compatible with such materials as Sulfur, Lead Arsenate and C-O-C-S Spray. Do not combine this material in the spray tank with such materials as Lime, Bordeaux Mixture or any materials of an alkaline nature. However, applications of this material may be made on crops that have been previously sprayed with the above materials. Spray tank, pump, pipelines, hose and nozzles should be washed out thoroughly after each day's use to avoid any corrosive action.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed: Give tablespoon of table salt in a glass of warm water. Repeat until vomiting occurs and vomitus is clear. Never induce vomiting in an unconscious person. Call a physician immediately.

If In Eye: Flush eye for 15 minutes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

If On Skin or Clothing: Remove contaminated clothing and shoes immediately. Bathe with soap and water. Call a physician immediately.

ANTIDOTE

Note to Physician: Active ingredient is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Patient should be kept under observation for 48 hours. Atropine is antidotal. Give 4 mg. intramuscularly or intravenously. Repeat every 15 minutes until patient is fully atropinized. If cyanotic give artificial respiration. Pralidoxime chloride (2-PAM) should be used in treatment.
