**Pesticide Storage**

Keep away from fire and sparks.

Keep out of reach of children and animals. Store in original containers only. Store in a cool, dry place and avoid excess heat. Carefully open containers. After partial use, fold and roll back bags, clamp and close tightly. Do not put concentrate or dilute material into food or drink containers. Do not contaminate other pesticides, fertilizers, water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

In case of spill, avoid contact, isolate area and keep off animals and unprotected persons. Confine spills. Call FMC collect: (716) 735-3765.

To confine spill: If liquid, dike surrounding area or absorb with sand, cat litter or commercial clay. If dry material, cover to prevent dispersal. Place damaged package in a holding container. Identify contents.

**Container Disposal**


**Statement of Practical Treatment**

Citrus: Rust Mite

Peaches: Brown Rot and Scab

For use on Citrus, it should be applied at the rate of 5 to 10 pounds per 100 gallons of water when Rust Mites become a problem.

For use on Peaches, apply 6 to 10 pounds per 100 gallons of water during the blossom, petal fall, and shuck fall stages and at 7 to 14 day intervals thereafter. More frequent applications may be required during periods of rainy weather.

To mix, fill tank half full and with agitator running, slowly add the required amount of this material. Finish filling tank. Keep agitated.

Do not apply on citrus within three weeks and on peaches within two weeks before or after an application of oil.

Applications of Dust and Spraying materials containing sulfur should not be made just prior to or during periods of excessively high temperatures.
