**Potatoes** White (Michigan only) Use 1 1/2 pounds per acre as a pre-planting treatment only. Apply broadcast to the soil and incorporate immediately prior to planting.

**Ornamental sod, Turf, and Nursery Stock** Insecticide for control of insects on sod, turf and nursery stock. Use 1 to 2 pounds per acre. Apply to the surface of the sod, turf or nursery stock. Water immediately to the depth of 1/2 inch. Do not water again until after applying. Do not use on sod or turf which is to be used for lawns or other areas where the sod or turf is to be exposed to the sun. **Potatoes White Grubs (Michigan only)** - Use 6½ pounds per acre as a pre-planting treatment only. Apply broadcast to the soil and immediately incorporate prior to planting.

**Ornamental sod, Turf, and Nursery Stock Japanese Beetle (Federal/State quarantine programs only)** - Use 6 to 12 pounds per acre (2½ to 5 ounces per 1000 sq. ft.) in sufficient water. Wash insecticide 4 to 6 inches into soil with water. For non-seeded areas, cultivate insecticide into soil to a depth of 4 to 6 inches immediately after applying. Keep children and domestic pets off treated area until it has been thoroughly watered and completely dry.
