## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This dust contains Toxaphene and Sulfur and is for use for the control of most cotton insects, including boll weevil, bollworm and leafworm, fall armyworm, flea beetles, grasshoppers, lygus bugs and other mirids and to aid in preventing the development of red spider and aphid. It may be used in early season applications, also, for the control of fleahoppers and thrips. Use just enough dust to apply a thin uniform coating over the entire plant, usually 10 to 20 lbs. per acre, and make repeated applications as needed during the growing season to afford protection to the plants and crop as they develop. This dust is most effective if applied when the air is calm.

For stink bugs on cotton, use 30 lbs. per acre. Do not apply to cotton after the bolls open.

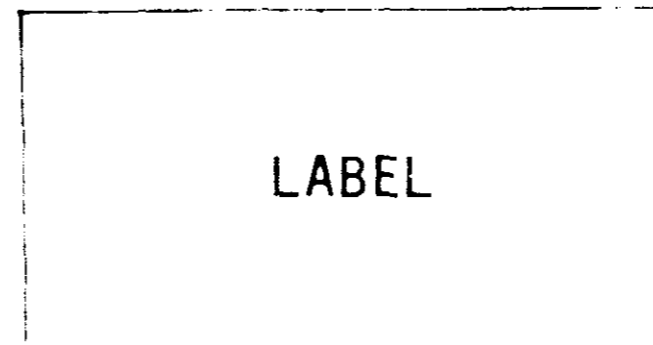
CAUTION: Do not graze dairy animals or animals being finished for slaughter in fields treated late in the season. Do not feed trash from treated cotton to such animals.
