

Pesticide Storage

Keep away from fire and sparks

Kolobrite insecticide is a wettable sulfur containing 13.5% w/w bentonite sulfur. Bentonite sulfur is made by adsorption of fused sulfur into bentonite in the proportions of 30 parts sulfur and 70 parts bentonite. A portion of the sulfur particles are very minute, some of them colloidal. The process of manufacture and the character of the sulfur particles impart to the product distinct properties with respect to persistence on plants, suspensibility in spray tank and safety to host plants.

Application of dusting and spraying material containing sulfur should not be used just prior to or during periods of excessively high temperatures. Do not use sulfur on citrus foliage within 3 weeks before or after an application of oil spray.

To mix Kolobrite, fill spray tank one-half to two-thirds full of water and with agitator running, slowly add the required amount of material. Fill spray tank and maintain agitation during spraying.

Citrus: To control Rust Mite -- Use Kolobrite at 10 pounds per 100 gallons of water. Apply when mites are present. Apply as a full coverage spray.
