DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use undiluted as dust at the rate of 25 to 40 pounds per acre, depending on the size of plants. For best results, make applications during calm damp periods with a machine that will cover plant surfaces with a thin film of dust.

CARROTS, BEET, TURNIPS: Cercospora Leaf Spot, Alternaria Leaf Spot on carrots. Apply when disease threatens and continue at 7 to 10 day intervals as needed. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest if tops are used for food or feed.

CABBAGE, SPINACH, LETTUCE: Downy Mildew - Apply when disease threatens and continue at 7 to 10 day intervals as needed. On cabbage do not apply within 7 days of harvest. On lettuce and spinach do not apply within 10 days of harvest.

CELERY: Downy Mildew - In plant beds apply when seed is planted and continue at 7 to 10 day intervals until transplanting. In field, begin applications when disease appears and continue at 7 to 10 day intervals as long as needed. Under severe conditions, shorten intervals to 3 to 5 days. Remove residue by washing and stripping. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

CUCUMBERS and SQUASH: Downy Mildew, Anthracnose. Apply as soon as plants appear above ground or when disease threatens and continue at 7 to 10 day intervals, as long as necessary to maintain control. Under severe conditions, shorten intervals to 3 to 5 days. Do not apply within 5 days of harvest.


TOMATOES: Late and Early Blight, Gray Leaf Spot, Anthracnose. Start applications when fruit of first clusters are well formed; repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals. When weather conditions favor late blight, more frequent applications may be necessary starting when plants are set in the fields. Do not apply within 5 days of harvest.

Apply at the rate of 25 to 40 pounds per acre. For best results, make applications during calm damp periods with a machine that will cover plant surfaces with a thin film of dust. For plants that are transplanted, begin applications when the leaves are the size of a dime or when the nodes are just starting to form. Make repeated applications twice a week and after each rain until the plants are transplanted. After the plants are set in the field, change dosage rate to 20 to 30 pounds per acre.

USAGE CAUTIONS

Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Dispose of wastes by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Dispose of bags by burying with wastes or by burning. Keep out of smoke.
