DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Make thorough, full coverage application when insects or disease first appear and repeat as necessary. May be applied by ground or air. Observe days interval between last application and harvest indicated by number in following the crop.

APPLES (3): Aphids, Mealybug, Codling Moth, Leafroller - Use 50 to 80 pounds per acre. May injure foliage on some varieties.

BEANS (1): Mexican Bean Beetle, Leafhoppers, Aphids, Cucumber Beetles, Powdery Mildew - Use 30 to 40 pounds per acre. Sulfur may injure certain varieties; check sulfur tolerance prior to use.

BLACKBERRIES (1), BOYSENBERRIES (1), DEWBERRIES (1), LOGANBERRIES (1), RASPBERRIES (1): Powdery Mildew, Aphids, Rose Scale - Use 40 to 60 pounds per acre.

BROCCOLI (3), CABBAGE (7), KALE (7), TURNIP (3): Aphids, Imported Cabbageworm, Cabbage Looper - Use 35 to 60 pounds per acre.

BRUSSELS SPROUTS (7), COLLARDS (7): Aphids, Caterpillars - Use 35 to 60 pounds per acre.

CARROTS (7): Aphids, Leafhoppers - Use 35 to 50 pounds per acre.

CAULIFLOWER (7): Aphids - Use 50 to 60 pounds per acre. Caterpillars - Use 25 pounds per acre.

CHERRIES (3): Black Cherry, Aphid, Fruit Tree Leafroller - Use 40 to 80 pounds per acre. May injure foliage on some varieties.

COTTON (0): Cotton Aphid, Leafhoppers, Whitefly, Cotton Leafworm, Cotton Leafroller, Thrips, Lygus Bug, Fleahoppers, Fall Armyworm, Green-striped Worm, Worms - Use 30 to 60 pounds per acre.

GRAPES (3): Leafhopper, Drosophila, Powdery Mildew - Use 30 to 50 pounds per acre. Enulsions may cause injury to foliage on some varieties. Ground application preferred.

LETTUCE (Head 7, Leaf 14): Aphids, Leafhoppers - Use 30 pounds per acre. Cabbage Looper - Use 35 to 50 pounds per acre.

MUSTARD GREENS (7): Aphids, Imported Cabbageworm, Cabbage Looper, Flea Beetles - Use 35 to 60 pounds per acre.

ONIONS: Thrips, Onion Maggots - Use 35 to 50 pounds per acre. Apply when Maggot Flies appear and repeat every 4 days. Make no application on green spring or bulb onions within 3 days of harvest.

This product contains Bentonite Sulfur which is made by the absorption of fused sulfur into Bentonite in the proportion of thirty parts sulfur and seventy parts Bentonite. A portion of the sulfur particles are very minute, some of them colloidal. The process of manufacture and the character of the sulfur particles impart to the product distinctive properties with respect to toxicity to certain fungi, persistence on plants, susceptibility in spray tank and safety to host plants.

PEACHES (7), NECTARINES (7): Pear, Silver Mite, Aphids, Oriental Fruit Moth - Use 50 to 80 pounds per acre.

PEARS (1): Pear Psylla, Mealybug, Codling Moth, Leafroller - Use 50 to 80 pounds per acre.

PEAS (3): Pea Aphid, Pea Weevil - Use 30 pounds per acre. Make no application within 7 days of harvest if vines are to be used for feed.

PECANS (0): Pecan Nut Casebearer - Use 100 pounds per acre. Apply when first third larvae begin to enter nuts and repeat after 7 days as necessary. Pear Bud Moth - Apply 10 pounds per acre by air. Apply 4 to 5 times, 2 to 3 weeks apart, after bud break.

PEPPERS (3): Pepper Weevil - Use 45 pounds per acre.

PLUMS (3), PRUNES (3): Aphids - Use 50 to 80 pounds per acre.

POTATOES (0): Aphids, Leafhoppers, Flea, Ground Bug, Mealybug - Use 30 to 60 pounds per acre.

STRAWBERRIES (3): Aphid, Lygus Bug, Spotted-winged Fly, Chiggers, Thrips, Rusty Leafhopper, Whitefly, Strawberry Leafroller, Powdery Mildew - Use 50 pounds per acre.

TOMATOES (1): Aphids, Tomato Russet Mite, Drosophila - Use 40 to 50 pounds per acre.

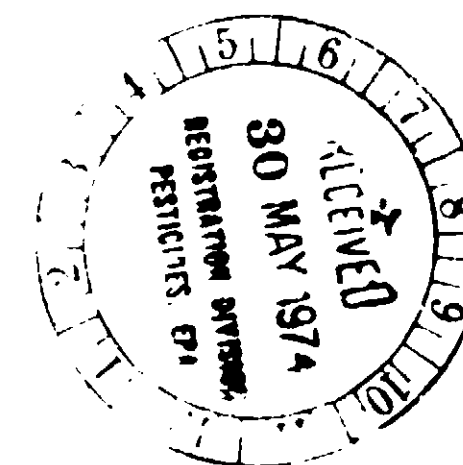
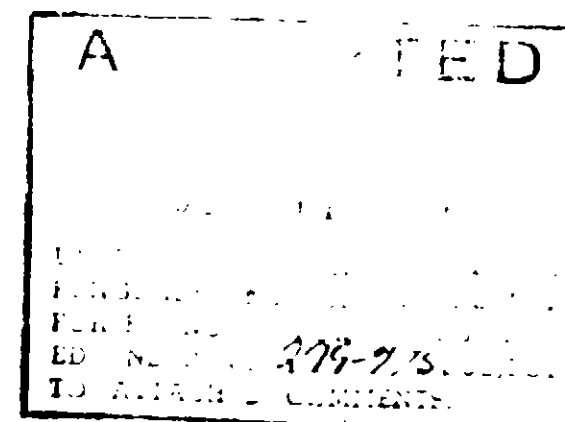
ORNAMENTALS: Aphid, Rust, Powdery Mildew - Make thorough full coverage application. Injury may occur on certain forms and on some species of ornamentals. Do not use on rose with pungent.

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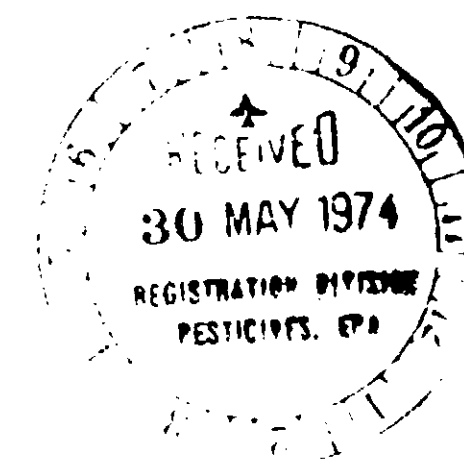
