

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This material is designed for use in dust applications for the control of Late Blight on Tomatoes in plant beds.

Begin application when plants begin to emerge. Applications should be made during damp periods (early morning or late afternoon) with a dusting machine that will give even coverage at the rate of 25 to 35 pounds per acre (1 to 1 1/2 pounds per 1000 square feet) depending upon the size of the plants. Applications should be repeated at intervals frequent enough to keep all new growth covered. Frequent light applications are more desirable than irregular heavy ones.

Applications of Dusting and Spraying materials containing sulfur should not be made just prior to or during periods of excessively high temperatures.

This product contains 13.5 percent bentonite sulfur.

Bentonite sulfur is made by the absorption of fused sulfur into bentonite in the proportions of thirty parts sulfur and seventy parts bentonite. A portion of the sulfur particles are very minute, some of them colloidal. The process of manufacture and the character of the sulfur particles impart to the product distinctive properties with respect to toxicity to certain fungi, persistence on plants, suspensibility in spray tank and safety to host plants.

Dispose of wastes by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Bags should be disposed of by burying with wastes or by burning. Keep out of smoke.
