MIXING DIRECTIONS

Before using this product, be sure the spray tank is clean and contains just enough water to cover the agitator shaft. With the agitator in motion (120 R.P.M. or more), add the amount of spray oil required for a full tank. Pump this mixture through the overflow and back into the tank for a minute or two. The mixture should turn white, indicating good emulsification. Then fill the tank with water. Keep agitator running at all times.

If an injector is used, first add 25 to 50 gallons of water to tank with engine running to provide good pressure. Then put injector suction tube into the measured amount of spray oil, opening injector valve to allow the oil to be sucked into the tank. Then fill the tank with water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply when pests first appear and repeat as necessary. Do not use in undiluted form. Apply the following recommended rates in sufficient water to thoroughly cover one acre.

CITRUS (Oranges, Lemons, Grapefruit): Use 1½ to 2 gallons of this material per 100 gallons of water for control of Yellow Scale, Citricola Scale, Red Scale and Soft Brown Scale.

OLIVES: Use 1½ to 2½ gallons of this material per 100 gallons of water in dormant, delayed dormant or summer periods for the control of Olive Scale, Black Scale and Oleander Scale.

DECIDUOUS TREES (Apples, Pears, Peaches, Plums, Prunes, Cherries, Almonds): Use 1 to 1½ gallons per 100 gallons of water in delayed dormant or summer periods for the control of Spider Mites. Certain varieties of plums and prunes may be injured by oil sprays, check tolerance to oil prior to treatment.

PEARS: After harvest for the control of Blister Mite, Bud Mite and Red Spider Mites use at the rate of 1½ to 2 gallons in combination with 4 to 6 pounds of FMC Kolofog per 100 gallons of dilute spray.
