Protective clothing means, at least, a hat or other suitable head covering, a long sleeved shirt and long legged trousers or a coverall type garment (all of closely woven fabric covering the body, including the arms and legs), shoes and socks.

CAUTION

Storage and Disposal

Pesticide Storage

Keep out of reach of children and animals. Store in original containers only. Store in a cool, dry place and avoid excess heat. Carefully open containers. After partial use, fold and roll back bags, clamp and close tightly. Do not put concentrate or dilute material into food or drink containers. Do not contaminate other pesticides, fertilizers, water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

In case of spill, avoid contact, isolate area and keep out animals and unprotected persons. Contain spills. Call FMC collect (716) 735-3785.

To contain spill, if liquid, dike surrounding area or absorb with sand, cat litter or commercial clay. If dry material, cover to prevent dispersal. Place damaged package in a holding container, identify contents.

Pesticide Disposal

Container Disposal

Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary and/or by incineration or if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Use 35 to 50 pounds of dust per acre. Apply dust uniformly and thoroughly to fruit and foliage. May be applied by aircraft or ground equipment. Make applications when air is quiet.

Apple: Bitter Rot, Black Rot (Frog Eye), and Scab—Use in delayed dormant, pink, petal fall, calyx and cover applications as required to maintain control. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest.

Cherry: Brown Rot and Leaf Spot. For Twig Brown Rot apply at pink bud. Repeat at full bloom and before shuck shed or every 4 days in cool, wet weather. For Blossom Blight, apply at popcorn, full bloom and petal fall. For Fruit Rot and Leaf Spot, use at 7 to 10 day intervals for cover applications. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest.

Peaches: Brown Rot—For Blossom Blight control apply at pink bud, full bloom and just before shuck fall. For Fruit Rot control apply at 7 to 10 day intervals the remainder of the season as necessary. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

Plums and Prunes: Brown Rot—For Blossom Blight control apply at pink, full bloom and pre-shuck fall or at 4 day intervals during cool, wet weather. For Fruit Rot control apply at 7 to 10 day intervals the remainder of the season as necessary. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest.

Usage Caution

Do not apply within 10 to 14 days of an oil spray. Do not apply prior to or during periods of excessively high temperatures (85°).

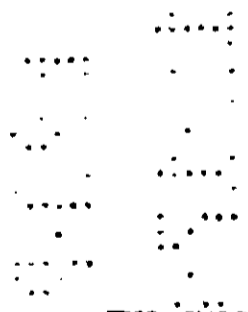
