DIRECTIONS FOR USE

BEANS (Including Dry, Green and Lima): Rust, Powdery Mildew, Armyworms, Corn Earworm, Climbing Cutworm, Thrips and to correct deficiencies of manganese.

Use as a dust at the rate of 40 to 50 pounds per acre depending upon the size of the plants. Begin applications when diseases or insects first appear and repeat as necessary for control (10 day intervals).

For best results make applications with a dusting machine that will give uniform coverage of all above-ground surfaces. Do not apply to green or snap beans within 7 days of harvest. Do not feed treated vines to dairy animals or animals being finished for slaughter. For disease control within this period the use of a suitable fungicide alone, such as Niagara Kolozim Bean Dust is recommended.

Applications of spraying or dusting materials containing sulfur should not be made just prior to or during periods of excessively high temperatures.

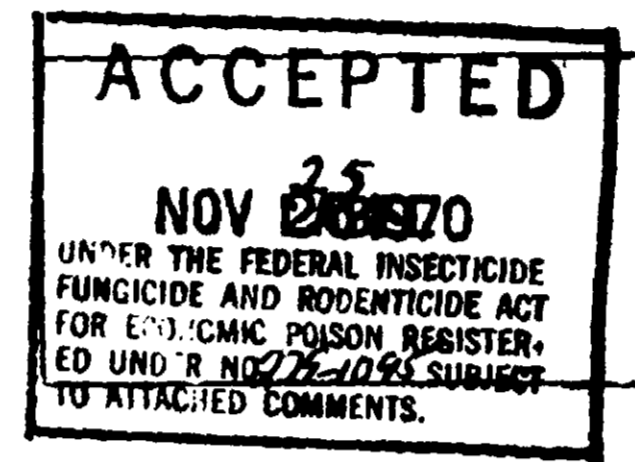
