STREPTOMYCIN 1000 DUST

Niagara Streptomycin 1000 Dust is a specially formulated Streptomycin-pyrophyllite dust containing 1000 ppm actual Streptomycin.

Apply this material as a dust. Full coverage is essential. May be applied with airplane or ground application equipment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

ON APPLES (West Coast) for control of fire Blight, use 40 lbs. per acre. Begin application in full bloom. Repeat in petal fall and late secondary bloom. Do not apply within 50 days of harvest.

ON PEARS (West Coast) for the control of Fire Blight use 40 lbs. per acre. Start at 10% bloom and repeat at 5 days interval until end of bloom. All blossoms should be protected ahead of periods of high humidity. Final application should not exceed 10 weeks after first bloom. Do not apply within 30 days of harvest.

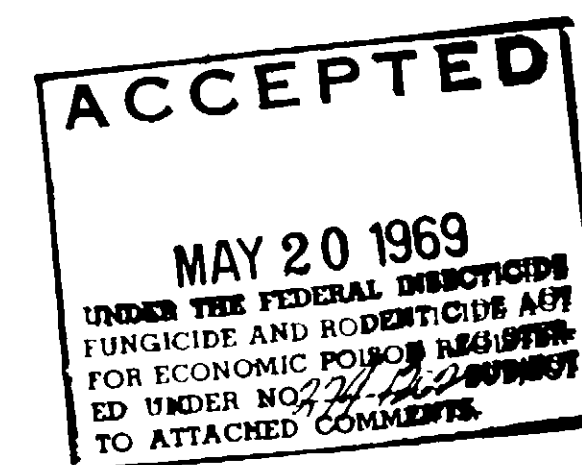

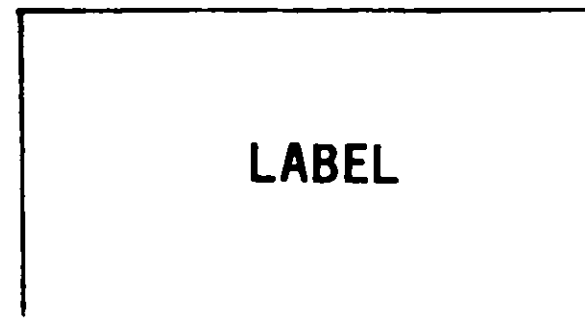
