# CITRUS SOLUBLE OIL-- LIGHT MEDIUM

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply when pests first appear. Apply the following recommended rates in sufficient water to thoroughly cover one acre. (With ground application equipment on citrus and olives, use a minimum of 200 gallons of diluted spray per acre). Do not use in undiluted form.

**CITRUS (Oranges, Lemons, Grapefruit):** Use 1½ to 2 gallons of this material per 100 gallons of water for control of Yellow Scale, Citricola Scale, Red Scale, Soft Brown Scale and Citrus Red Mite.

**OLIVES:** Use 1½ to 2 gallons of this material per 100 gallons of water for control of Olive Scale, Black Scale and Oleander Scale.

Special attention has been given in the formulation of Niagara Citrus Soluble Oil to make it compatible with wettable powder materials such as Niagara Phoskil 25 Spray, Niagara Malathion 25 Spray, and products used for the correction of minor element deficiencies.

## MIXING DIRECTIONS

Before using this product, be sure the spray tank is clean and contains just enough water to cover the agitator shaft. If an injector is used, first add 25 to 50 gallons of water to tank with engine running to provide good pressure. Then put injector suction tube into the measured amount of spray oil, opening injector valve to allow the oil to be sucked into the tank. Then fill the tank with water. With enough water in tank to cover agitator shaft and with shaft in motion, add desired amount of this material for full tank. Pump this mixture through the overflow and back into tank for about two minutes to insure proper emulsification. Fill with water, adding other desired materials as tank is filling. Keep agitator running at all times. Sufficient agitation must be present to insure proper emulsification at all times. Keep agitator running at all times.
