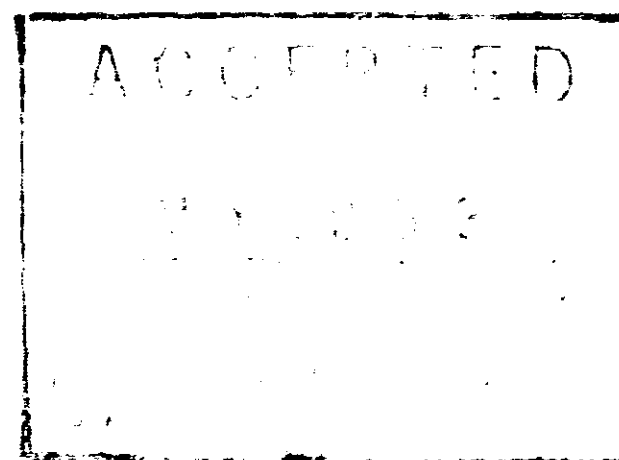
# KOLODUST PARATHION 2 DUST

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Not for use or storage in residential areas.

PEACH: Areas other than California. Plum Curculio, Oriental Fruit Moth, Gummy Scale, Mites, Brown Rot, Peach Scab. Apply at the rate of 1.3 to 1.2 pound per average sized peach tree. Make first application at the full split stage and repeat at 5 to 7 day intervals during the period when plum curculio are present. After this period repeat at weekly intervals. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest. During this latter period Niagara Kolodust may be used to control scab and brown rot. Do not apply more than 5 pounds actual parathion per acre per year.

Application of dusting and spraying materials containing sulfur should not be made just prior to or during periods of excessively high summer temperatures.

WARNING: Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin! Rapidly absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles. In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and water. Wear a mask or respirator of a type passed by the U.S. Bureau of Mines for Parathion protection. Keep all unprotected persons and beneficial animals out of operating area or vicinity where there may be danger of drift. Vacated areas should not be re-entered until drifting insecticide and volatile residues have dissipated. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before re-use.

Note to Physician: Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

Do not use in residential areas. Do not expose to wind-blown drift or residue on crops. Protective clothing may be obtained from your Cooperative Agricultural Extension Service.

DISPOSE OF WASTES by burying at least 18 inches deep in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Do not reuse or burn containers contaminated with wastes.
