
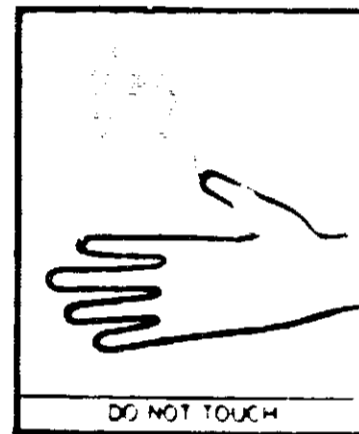


DANGER—POISON—PRECAUTIONS 

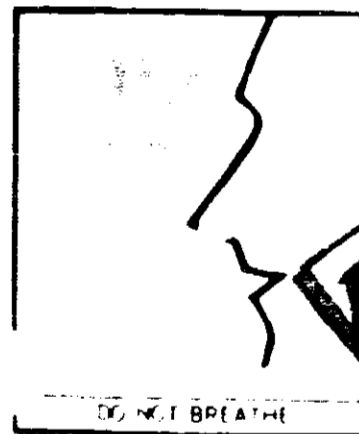
POISONOUS IF SWALLOWED

This product can kill you if swallowed even in small amounts. Spray mist or dust may be fatal if swallowed.



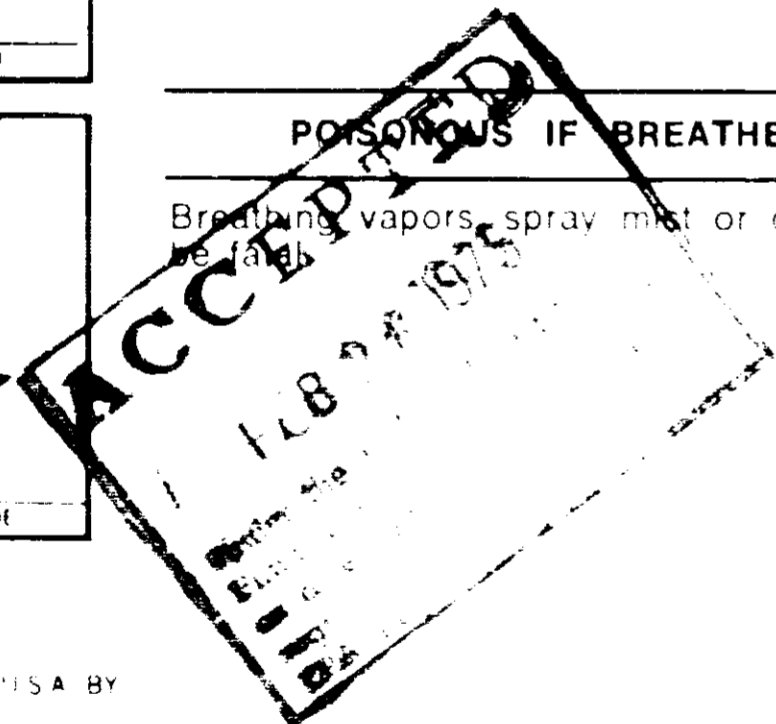
POISONOUS BY SKIN CONTACT

Poisonous if touched by hands or spilled or splashed on skin, in eyes or on clothing (liquid goes through clothes.)

WORK SAFETY RULES

Do not eat, drink, or smoke while working with this material. Wash hands and face with soap and water after work.

IMPORTANT: Before removing gloves, wash them with soap and water. Always wash hands, face, and arms with soap and water before smoking, eating, or drinking.

AFTER WORK: Take off all work clothes and shoes, shower using soap and water. Wash only clean clothes when leaving job. Do not wear contaminated clothes. Wash protective clothing and protective equipment with soap and water after each use. Respirator should be cleaned and filter replaced according to instructions included with respirator.

PARATHION is a very dangerous poison. It rapidly enters the body on contact with all skin surfaces and eyes. Clothing wet with this material must be removed immediately. Exposed persons must receive prompt medical treatment if they may die.

Some of the signs and symptoms of poisoning are: headache, nausea, vomiting, cramps, weakness, blurred vision, dilated pupils, dizziness, chest, labored breathing, nervousness, sweating, watering of eyes, drooping of eyelids, drooping of mouth and nose, muscle spasms, and coma.

FIRST AID TREATMENT

Call a doctor if symptoms appear. Do not delay. Explain that it is **PARATHION** and give the name of the manufacturer.

If breathing has stopped, start artificial respiration immediately and maintain until doctor arrives.

If swallowed and victim is awake, give one or two glasses of water quickly. Induce vomiting by sticking finger down the throat by gag reflex. Do not give any water to drink. Repeat until vomit is clear. Never give anything by mouth to a comatose person. Do not give anything by mouth to a comatose person.

In case of contact, wash eyes with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Wash skin with soap and water for 15 minutes. Wash hair with soap and water for 15 minutes.
