DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply when insects first appear and repeat as required to maintain control. Dust plants thoroughly paying particular attention to the undersides of the leaves. Observe days interval between last application and harvest indicated by number in () following crop.

BEANS (1). Aphids Use 12½ pounds per acre. Grasshoppers, Leafhoppers, Mites, Mexican Bean Beetle Use 12½ to 25 pounds per acre.

BROCCOLI (1), BRUSSELS SPROUTS (3), CABBAGE (1), CAULIFLOWER (3), COLLARDS (3): Aphids - Use 6 to 12 pounds per acre. Cabbage Looper, Imported Cabbage worm, Grasshoppers, Climbing Cutworms, Lygus Bugs - Use 12 to 25 pounds per acre.

CELERY (3): Aphids Use 12½ pounds per acre. Dipterous Leafminer (Adults), Lygus Bugs, Leafhoppers, Cabbage Looper, Mites Use 12½ to 25 pounds per acre.

CORN, Field & Sweet (1) Aphids Use 12½ to 25 pounds per acre.

CUCUMBERS (1): Aphids Use 12½ pounds per acre. Grasshoppers, Leafhoppers, Mites Use 12½ to 25 pounds per acre.

LETTUCE (2) Aphids Use 12½ pounds per acre. Corn Earworm, Cutworms (climbing), Cabbage Looper, Imported Cabbageworm, Leafhoppers, Mites, Lygus Bugs Use 12½ to 25 pounds per acre.

ONION (1) Cutworms (climbing), Thrips Use 12½ to 25 pounds per acre.

PEAS(1), TOMATOES (1) Aphids Use 12½ pounds per acre. Grasshoppers, Leafhoppers, Mites Use 12½ to 25 pounds per acre.

POTATOES (1) Aphids, Grasshoppers, Leafhoppers, Mites Use 12½ pounds per acre.


Note to Physician: Atropine is antidotal. 2 PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.


This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on crops. Protective information may be obtained from your Cooperative Agricultural Extension Service.
