DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Application of this material should be made by ground duster equipment, taking particular care to make application when the air is still. Avoid dust drift to nearby crops.

FOR APPLE THINNING

This dust is approximately equal in its effectiveness to that of a spray containing 20 ppm. naphthaleneacetic acid. Use 40 pounds of dust per acre. Apply uniformly to fruit 10 to 21 days after calyx-petal-fall period.

CAUTION: Chemical thinning involves some risk. The exact extent of thinning cannot be predicted in advance. It should be realized that attempts to determine the time of application of these growth regulators on the basis of days after petal-fall is not entirely satisfactory.

Prevailing temperatures play a primary role in the physiological development of the young fruit and seed. If the temperatures are cooler than normal after petal-fall, the time of application should be delayed, but not exceed 21 days after calyx.

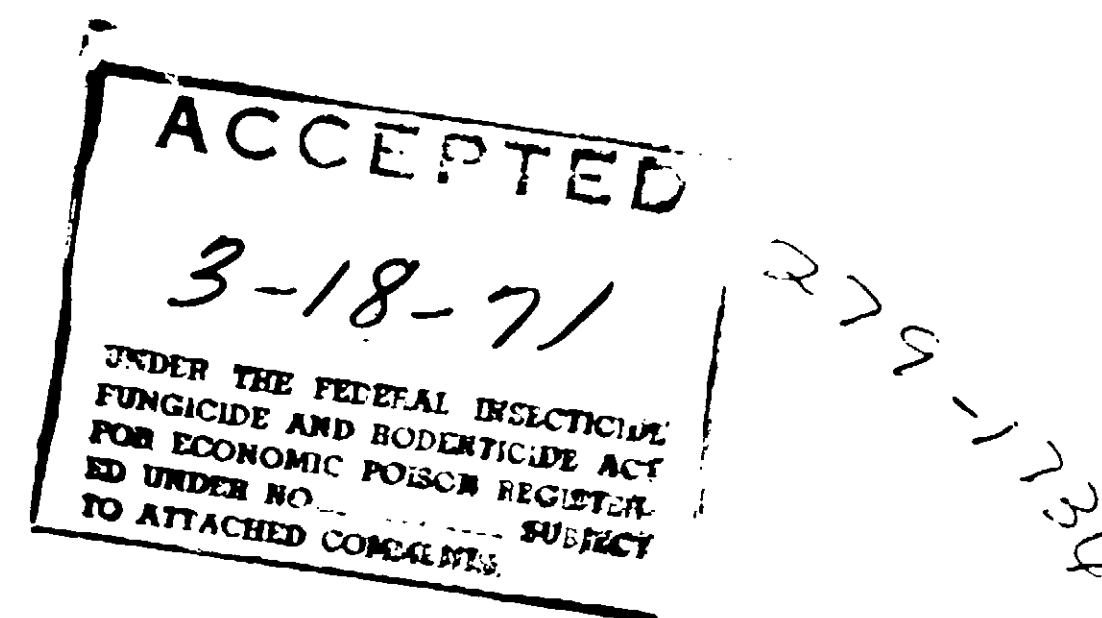

DISPOSE OF WASTES by burning in non-crop land, far away from water supplies. Container should be disposed of by burying with wastes or by burning. Keep out of smoke.



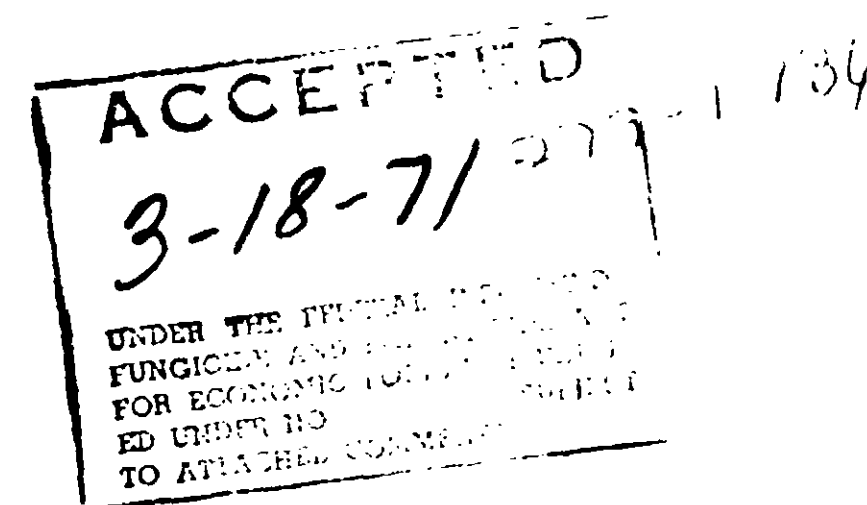
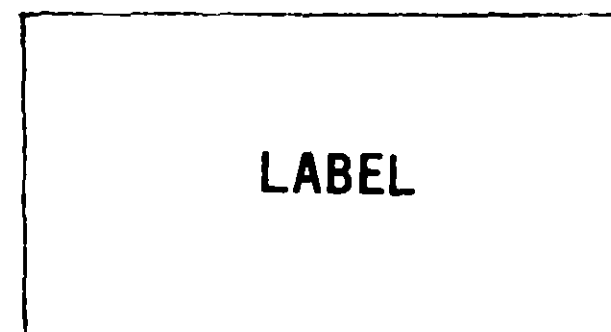
FOR DROP CONTROL OF APPLES

APPLES - Use 40 pounds of dust per acre. Apply to fruit 7 to 14 days before harvest. Do not make more than 2 applications. Do not apply within 2 days of harvest.

The effectiveness of this material in preventing apple drop depends upon good coverage and foliage free from late blight, magnesium deficiency, frost injury and severe scab infection. Little or no effect can be expected if foliage is in poor condition or drought is prevalent. It is important that fruit be picked at the proper stage of maturity and not allowed to become over-ripe.

Harvesting of the crop should not be delayed until the effectiveness of this dust application has been lost and until the keeping qualities of the fruit have been impaired.
