DIRECTIONS FOR USE

On Apples and PEARS to control European Red Mite, Two-spot Mite, Parasitic Mite, MacDermott Mite, Apple Rust Mite, Apple Maggot, Orange Tortrix, Codling Moth, Green Apple Aphid and Green Fruit Worm. Use at the rate of 40-60 pounds per acre. Apply when the insects first appear and repeat as necessary. To avoid possible fruit thinning do not apply until 30 days after bloom. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

On PEACHES, PRUNES and PLUMS to control European Red Mite, Two-spot Mites, Oriental Fruit Moth, Codling Moth and Peach Twig Borer. Use at the rate of 40-60 pounds per acre. Apply when the insects first appear and repeat as necessary. On Peaches may be applied up to 4 days of harvest. On Prunes and Plums may be applied up to 7 days of harvest but do not repeat applications within 30 days of the preceding application.
