DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Maybe applied with airplane or ground application equipment.

Apply as a dust when insects appear and repeat as necessary.

ON ALFALFA to control Alfalfa Caterpillar, Beet Armyworm, Lygus Bugs, Stink Bugs, Variegated Cutworms, Western Yellow-Striped Armyworm, and Atlantic Mites use 20 lbs. per acre. On hay, make one application per cutting. Do not apply within 14 days of cutting or grazing.

ON COTTON to control Beet Armyworm, Lygus Bugs, Salt Marsh Caterpillar, Stink Bugs, Western Yellow-striped Armyworm, Atlantic Mites, Cotton Leafworm, Fleahoppers and Cotton Leaf Perforator use 20-30 lbs. per acre. Repeat as necessary. Do not pasture treated fields within 14 days of application. Do not apply within 7 days of picking.
