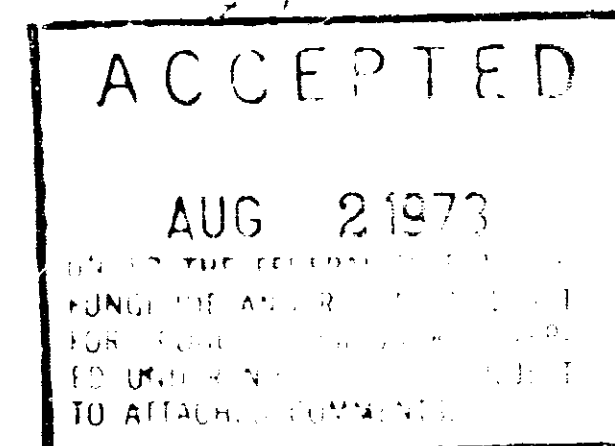

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Not for use or storage in or around the home.

Apply when insects first appear and repeat as required to maintain control. Observe days interval between last application and harvest indicated by the number in () following the crop. Observe use limitations.

ALFALFA (21), CLOVER (21): Alfalfa Plant Bug, Aphids, Flea Hoppers, Leafhoppers, Lygus Bugs, Mites, Spittlebug - Use 20 to 25 pounds per acre. Do not apply more than once between cuttings.

APPLES (7), CRABAPPLES (7), PEARS (7), QUINCES (7): Aphids, Apple Maggot, Codling Moth, European Apple Sawfly, Five Spotted Bud Moth, Fruit Tree Leaf Roller, Leafhoppers, Mites, Plum Curculio, Red-banded Leaf Roller - Use 35 to 40 lbs. per acre. Do not apply more than 8 times per season.

APRICOTS (21), NECTARINES (21), PEACHES (21): Aphids, Mites, Plum Curculio, Red-banded Leaf Roller - Use 35 to 40 lbs. per acre.

BLUEBERRIES: Blueberry Maggot, Lecanium Scale, Plum Curculio, Fruitworms, Leaf Miner - Use 20 lbs. per acre. Do not apply more than 8 times per season. Do not apply within 9 hours of harvest.

BROCCOLI (25), BRUSSELS SPROUTS (7), CABBAGE (21), CAULIFLOWER (25): Aphids, Cabbage Looper, Imported Cabbageworm, Diamondback Moth, Larvae - Use 20 to 25 lbs. per acre.

CHERRIES (15): Five-spotted Bud Moth, Fruit Tree Leaf Roller, Mites, Plum Curculio - Use 35 to 40 lbs. per acre. Do not apply more than 8 times per season.

GRAPES (10): Grape Berry Moth, Leafhoppers, Mites, Red-banded Leaf Roller - Use 25 to 40 lbs. per acre. Do not apply more than 8 times per season.

POTATOES (7): Aphids, Colorado Potato Beetle, Flea Beetle, Leafhoppers, Leaf Miners, Spittle Bug, Tarnished Plant Bug - Use 20 to 25 pounds per acre.

TOBACCO (6): Aphids, Tobacco Hornworm, Tobacco Flea Beetle - Use 20 to 25 lbs. per acre. Tobacco Budworms - Use 25 lbs. per acre. For Budworm control, make application directly into bud. Treat for hornworm as soon as egg masses or worms are first found. Second brood hornworms may require two applications, one in late July and another in August. Flea beetles may require two applications, one about August first and another about two weeks later. Repeat as necessary. Prime before treating.

PINE TREES: European Pine Shoot Moth, Nantucket Pine Tip Moth - Use 15 to 30 lbs. per acre. Use maximum rates for tip moth control in Canada.

DANGER: Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Rapidly absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles. In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and water. Wear a mask or respirator of a type passed by the U. S. Bureau of Mines for Guthion protection. Keep all unprotected persons and beneficial animals out of operating area or vicinity where there may be danger of drift. Vacated areas should not be re-entered for at least two days. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before re-use.

Do not use on other crops used for feed or forage. Treated orchards should not be pastured.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed: Give tablespoon of table salt in a glass of warm water. Repeat until vomiting occurs and vomitus is clear. Never induce vomiting in an unconscious person. Call a physician immediately.

If In Eye: Flush eye for 15 minutes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

If On Skin or Clothing: Remove contaminated clothing and shoes immediately. Bathe with soap and water. Call a physician immediately.

ANTIDOTE

Note to Physicians: Guthion is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Patient should be kept under observation for 48 hours. Atropine is antidotal. Give 4 mg. intramuscularly or intravenously. Repeat every 15 minutes until patient is fully atropinized. If cyanotic give artificial respiration. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

USAGE CAUTIONS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Keep out of lakes, ponds and streams. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

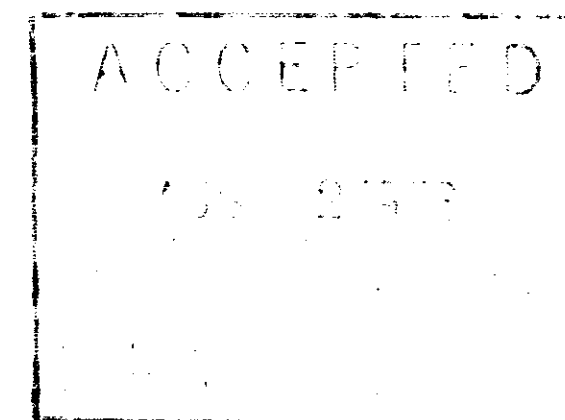
