Not For Use or Storage In or Around The Home


Apply the following recommended rates in sufficient water to thoroughly cover one acre. (By ground, apply on Pome Fruits a minimum of 300 gals.; on Stone Fruits a minimum of 200 gals.; on Vegetable crops a minimum of 10 gals. of spray per acre. By air, on Tree crops apply a minimum of 15 gals.; on Vegetable crops a minimum of 1 gal. of spray per acre). Do not use in undiluted form. May be applied with ground or airplane application equipment.

Cherries: Cherry Fruit Fly - Use 1 qt. per 100 gallons of water in a full coverage spray. Apply when the adult flies first appear, and repeat every 10 days until harvest. Do not apply within 2 days of harvest. Repeat sprays after harvest if the flies still occur.

Lettuce: Leafhoppers, Imported Cabbage Worms, Cabbage Loopers, Alfalfa Loopers (Calif.) - Use 2 qts. per acre in sufficient amount of water to cover. Apply when insects first appear. Repeat as necessary. Do not apply within 4 days of harvest.

Pears: Pear Psylla - Use 1 to 2 qts. per 100 gallons of water (8 to 16 qts. per acre). Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. Use is primarily for pears, but may be applied to orchards interplanted with pears and apples. Do not use treated apples in the manufacture of pomace for livestock feed. For rates of 8 to 16 qts. per acre apply as pre-bloom and/or post-bloom sprays and up to 2 cover sprays. Allow 30 days between cover sprays. For rates up to 8 qts. per acre apply up to 4 cover sprays starting in late May or early June or apply first two cover sprays 7 to 14 days apart and wait 30 days to apply two additional cover sprays 7 to 14 days apart as needed.

Spinach: Leafhoppers, Cabbage Loopers - Use 1 qt. per acre in sufficient water to cover. Apply when insects first appear and repeat as necessary. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.
