DIRECTIONS FOR USE

PEACHES: Oriental fruit moth, Peach twig borer, Plum Curculio, Catfacing insects, Periodical Cicada, Brown Rot, Scab. Use at the rate of 35 to 40 pounds of dust per acre. Apply when shucks begin to split and repeat at 5 to 7 day intervals as required to maintain control. Do not apply within one day of harvest.

Do not apply within three weeks before or after an oil application.

COTTON: Boll Weevil, Bollworm, Cotton Fleahopper, Lygus Bugs, Pink Bollworm, Thrips. Use the following amounts of dust per acre for.

Early Season	10 to 15 pounds
Mid-Season	15 to 20 pounds
Late-Season	20 to 25 pounds

Apply when insects first threatens damage to crop and repeat at 5 to 7 day intervals as required to maintain control.

Applications of spraying or dusting materials containing sulfur should not be made just prior to or during periods of excessively high temperatures.

This product contains 13.5 percent bentonite sulfur.

Bentonite sulfur is made by the absorption of fused sulfur into bentonite in the proportions of thirty parts sulfur and seventy parts bentonite. A portion of the sulfur particles are very minute some of them colloidal. The process of manufacture and the character of the sulfur particles impart to the product distinctive properties with respect to toxicity to certain fungi, persistence on plants, suspensibility in spray tank and safety to host plants.
