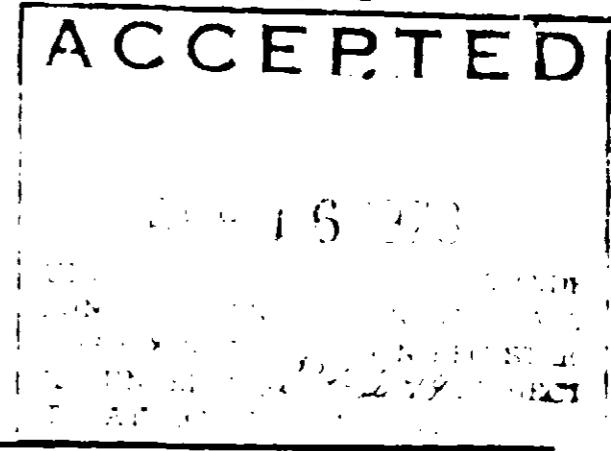

# PARATHION 2 THIODAN<sup>®</sup> 3 DUST

INSECTICIDE



### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

NOT FOR USE OR STORAGE IN OR AROUND THE HOME.

Apply 25 lbs. of this material per acre unless otherwise noted to control the following insects on the crops shown below. Apply when the air is calm by ground machinery. Thorough coverage of the plant is necessary for effective control. Observe days interval between last application and harvest indicated by number in parenthesis following crop.

**TOMATOES (10)** For the control of Aphids, Colorado Potato Beetle, Flea Beetle and Whitefly.

**HEAD LETTUCE (14)** For the control of Cabbage Looper, Green Peach Aphid, Diamond-back Moth, Larvae, and Imported Cabbage Worm. Note: Do not make more than 3 applications after thinning. Remove wrapper leaves at harvest. Do not feed crop refuse to livestock.

**PEPPERS (15)** For the control of Flea beetle and Green Peach Aphid.

**POTATOES (5)** For the control of Flea Beetle, Colorado Potato Beetle, Three-lined Beetle, Leafhopper, Aphids and Plant Bugs, Potato Tuberworm, and Whitefly. Do not plant root crops other than carrots, potatoes, sugar beets, and sweet potatoes as follow-up crop.

**BROCCOLI (7)** **BRUSSELS SPROUTS (14)** **CABBAGE (10)** **CAULIFLOWER (11)** For the control of Cabbage Aphids, Cabbage Looper, Imported Cabbage worm, Diamond-back Moth, Larvae, Cross striped Cabbage worm, Flea Beetle, Helixian Bug, Stink Bug.

**BEANS (Snap and Dry) (7)** Mexican Bean Beetle, Leafhopper, Aphid, Leaf Roller, Armyworms, Leaf Miner. 15 to 20 lbs. per acre. Do not graze or feed treated threshings to livestock. Do not apply more than 3 times per season. Do not use on Lima Beans where the vines are to be removed from the field for processing.

**KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN**

Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Rapidly absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles. In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and water. Wear a mask or respirator of a type passed by the U.S. Bureau of Mines for Parathion protection. Keep all unprotected persons and beneficial animals out of operating area or vicinity where there may be danger of drift. Vacated areas should not be re-entered until drifting insecticide and volatile residues have dissipated. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before re-use.

Note to Physician: Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Cont.)

**MELONS (7)** **CUCUMBER (7)** **SQUASH (15)** **PUMPKINS (10)** Aphids, Cucumber Beetles, Striped Cabbage Flea Beetle, Spruce Vine Borer, Stink Bugs, Melonworms, Pickleworm, Squash Vine Borer, Lead Miner. Do not apply to cucurbits unless plants are dry. Make no applications before plants start to vine.

**TOBACCO (15)** Flea Beetles, Hairyworm, Budworm, Green Peach Aphid. Use 25 pounds of dust per acre. Thorough coverage is essential for good control. Make no application within 5 days of pruning. Avoid getting wet with plant juices when cutting or pruning.

**COTTON** For the control of Spider Mites, Desert Spider Mite, Tarned Spider Mite, Two-spotted Spider Mite, Boll Weevil, Aphids, Cotton Leafworm, Lygus Bug, Bollworm, and Cabbage Looper. **NOTE:** Do not apply after 25% of the bolls open or within 7 days of hand picking. Do not graze hay or feed crops in treated fields. Workers entering treated fields within 24 hours after application should wear protective clothing.

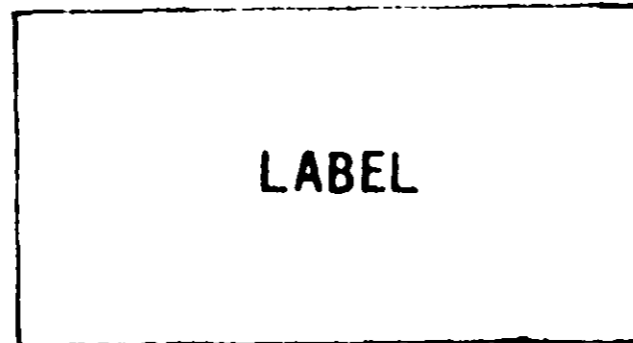
### USAGE CAUTIONS

Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on the label.
