ZINC PHOSPHIDE MOUSE BAIT 201

RODENTICIDE

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This bait is most effective if it falls through the grass to the ground surface where the mice will easily find it and where it will be largely hidden from birds and other wildlife. Distribute after apple harvest and before leaf-fall.

NURSERIES, ORCHARDS: Meadow Mice, Pine Mice, Pocket Mice, Whitefooted Mice - METHODS OF APPLICATION: 1. Drop one teaspoonful of zinc phosphide treated grain directly into the surface trail (or holes entering a sub surface burrow system) at 2 - 4 places about the base of each infested tree. Cover the baited trail by pulling the overhanging grass back into place, or covering with a mat of loose mulch.

2. If bait is distributed in a modified corn planter, set the plate to drop one treated kernel per inch and lay a line along both sides of the tree row just inside the drip line of the tree.

3. If broadcast by a hand cyclone seeder use no more than 6 to 10 lbs. per acre.

4. From the standpoint of effectiveness and safety for birds and other beneficial wildlife, the hand placement directly into runs and burrows, in which bait spots are subsequently covered, is the preferred method.

BAIT STATIONS: Use one tablespoonful of bait in each bait station. Use suitable bait boxes and cages that are designed to protect other animals from the bait. Place bait stations around barn and barnyard areas as well as in fruit and vegetable storage areas.

Repeat applications of field treatment and bait stations if necessary, depending upon the severity of the infestation or where continuous infestation results from nearby dumps or untreated fields.

Do not broadcast this bait over crops where there is likelihood of the bait hanging up in the axil of foliage, later harvested for food or feed.


USAGE CAUTIONS

This product is toxic to wildlife. Birds and other wildlife feeding in treated areas may be killed. When broadcasting bait, scatter evenly and do not apply to bare ground. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Rinse equipment and DISPOSE OF WASTES by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Container should be disposed by burying with wastes or by burning. Keep out of smoke.

This rodenticide contains sized and screened cracked corn and oats which gives more surface per unit of kernel and permits better impregnation by the Zinc Phosphide which is carried into the kernel with the Mineral Seal Oil. Animal Fat is added to coat the kernel which inhibits weathering and prolongs the toxicity after field application.
