CITRUS SOLUBLE OIL - HEAVY MEDIUM

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

NIAGARA CITRUS SOLUBLE OIL (Heavy Medium) is an emulsive spray oil for use on citrus at 1 1/2-1 3/4 gallons per 100 gallons of spray for the control of citrus red mite, red, yellow, black, purple and citricola scale. It may also be used at 1 2/3 to 2 gallons per 100 gallons as a summer spray in the control of parlatoria and oleander scales on olives.

Special attention has been given in the formulation of Niagara Citrus Soluble Oil to make it compatible with wettable powder materials such as Niagara Phoskil 25 Spray, Niagara Malathion 25 Spray, and products used for the correction of minor element deficiencies.

MIXING DIRECTIONS

Before using this product, be sure the spray tank is clean and contains just enough water to cover the agitator shaft.

If an injector is used, first add 25 to 50 gallons of water to tank with engine running to provide good pressure. Then put injector suction tube into the measured amount of spray oil, opening injector valve to allow the oil to be sucked into the tank. Then fill the tank with water. With enough water in tank to cover agitator shaft and with shaft in motion, add desired amount of this material for full tank. Pump this mixture through the overflow and back into tank for about two minutes to insure proper emulsification. Fill with water, adding other desired materials as tank is filling. Keep agitator running at all times. Sufficient agitation must be present to insure proper emulsification at all times.



USAGE CAUTIONS

Plants should be sprayed only when in vigorous condition and when their moisture condition is suitable.

Do not make oil spray applications within 10 days to two weeks prior to or after applications of Sulphur or dinitro materials such as Morocide or Karathane.

Rinse equipment and containers and DISPOSE OF WASTES by burying in non-crop land away from water supplies. Empty 1 and 5 gallon cans should be smashed and buried with wastes. Empty drums should be returned to your pesticide supplier. Do not re-use.

Do not allow this material to drift onto neighboring crops or non-crop areas or use in a manner or at a time other than in accordance with label directions because animal, plant or crop injury, illegal residues or other undesirable results may occur.
