METHYL PARA

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply when pests first appear and repeat as necessary to maintain control. Use the following recommended rate in sufficient water to thoroughly cover one acre. (By ground apply a minimum of 10 gals.; by air apply sufficient water for thorough coverage but not less than 1 gallon of finished spray per acre). Observe days interval between last application and harvest as indicated in () following the crop.

TOMATOES (15): Blister Beetle, Colorado Potato Beetle, Flea Beetles, Green Peach Aphid, Tomato Hornworm, Webworm (Calif. Only), Whitefly - Use 1½ pints to 1/3 gallon per acre. Cabbage Looper, Stink Bug - Use 1/4 - 1/3 gallon per acre. Tomato Fruitworm, Armyworms, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, Aphids, Tomato Russet Mite - Use 1/3 gallon per acre.)

BROCCOLI (21), **CABBAGE** (21), **BRUSSELS SPROUTS** (21), **CAULIFLOWER** (21): Aphids, Cabbage Looper, Cross-striped Cabbageworm, Diamond-back Moth Larvae, Flea Beetle, Harlequin Bug, Imported Cabbageworm, Stink Bug - Use 1/4 - 1/3 gallon per acre. Armyworms, Leafhoppers - Use 1/3 gallon per acre.

DRY and SUCCULENT BEANS (21): Black Bean Aphid, Bean Leaf Skeletonizer, Cucumber Beetles, Green Stink Bug, Mexican Bean Beetle - Use 1½ pints - 1/3 gallon per acre. Aphids, Armyworms, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers - Use 1/3 gallon per acre. Make no more than 3 applications per season. Do not use on lima beans that are to be removed from the field for processing. Do not feed treated threshings to livestock or allow to graze in treated fields.

ANTIDOTE: If swallowed, give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have victim lie down and keep quiet. **CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY:** If on skin, in case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with soap and water.

Methyl Parathion is a cholinesterase inhibitor and treatment of poisoning should include the use of atropine; Thiodan produces central nervous system excitation which responds to the barbituric acid derivatives. **ATROPINE IS ANTIDOTAL.**

Keep on hand an emergency supply of 20 tablets, grains 1/100. In case of poisoning take 3 tablets, grains (1/100) and call a physician at once.


PHYSICIAN: Enough atropine must be given in the shortest practical time to produce dilation of pupils. Patient must be under constant supervision and additional atropine may be necessary without delay. Clear chest by postural drainage. Use artificial respiration and oxygen if patient becomes comatose. Use of airway may be necessary.
