# CRYOLITE 30 PARATHION 2 TOXAPHENE 10 DUST

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply when insects first appear and repeat as necessary. May be applied by ground or air. Observe days interval between last application and harvest indicated by number in ( ) following the crop.

**BEANS (15):** Aphids, Leafhopper, Armyworm, Bean Leafroller, Leafminer — Use 25 pounds per acre. Corn Earworm, Cucumber Beetles — Use 37 pounds per acre. Climbing Cutworms — Use 40 pounds per acre. Remove excess residues by washing, brushing or other effective means. Do not feed treated vines to dairy animals or animals being finished for slaughter.

**CABBAGE (10), BROCCOLI (30), BRUSSELS SPROUTS (30), COLLARDS (21), CAULIFLOWER (30):** Aphids, Cabbage Looper, Diamondback Moth Larvae, Imported Cabbageworm, Climbing Cutworms, Armyworms, Corn Earworm, Thrips, Leafminer, Flea Beetles — Use 25 pounds per acre. On Cabbage do not apply after heads start to form; on Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts and Cauliflower do not apply after edible parts start to form; on Collards do not apply after the seedling stage.

**LETTUCE (Head - 7 Leaf - 21):** Aphids, Armyworm, Cabbage Loopers, Imported Cabbageworm, Cucumber Beetle, Climbing Cutworm, Flea Beetle, Grasshoppers — Use 25 pounds per acre. Do not apply after the seedling stage on leaf lettuce or after heads begin to form on head lettuce.

**PEPPERS (15):** Springdale Hornworm, Pepper Weevil, Armyworm, Blister Beetle, Climbing Cutworm, Corn Earworm — Use 30 pounds per acre. Aphids, Flea Beetles — Use 25 pounds per acre. Remove excess residues by washing, brushing or other effective means. Do not apply after peppers begin to form.

#### FIRST AID

**Call a Physician Immediately! If Swallowed:** Give a table spoonful of salt in a glass of warm water. Repeat until vomiting ceases and vomitus is clear. Have victim lie down and keep quiet. Never induce vomiting in an unconscious person.

**If in Eyes:** Flush eyes for 15 minutes with plenty of water.

**If on Skin or Clothing:** Remove contaminated clothing and bathe immediately. Bathe with soap and water.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Parathion is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Patient should be kept under observation for 48 hours. Atropine is antidotal. Give 4 mg intramuscularly or intravenously repeat every 15 minutes until patient is fully atropinized. If cyanotic, give artificial respiration. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be used in conjunction with atropine. Toxaphene is a central nervous system stimulant, produces central nervous excitation and may cause convulsions. There is no specific antidote however it ordinarily responds to barbituric acid derivatives. This drug should be considered only if complete atropinization fails to relieve symptoms. Barbituric acid derivatives may be used to relieve symptoms. Treat symptoms as usual.

May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Rapidly absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles. In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and water. Wear a mask or respirator of a type passed by the U.S. Bureau of Mines for Parathion protection. Keep all unreflected persons and beneficial animals out of operating area or vicinity where there may be danger of drift. Vacated areas should not be reentered until drifting insecticide and volatile residues have dissipated. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse.

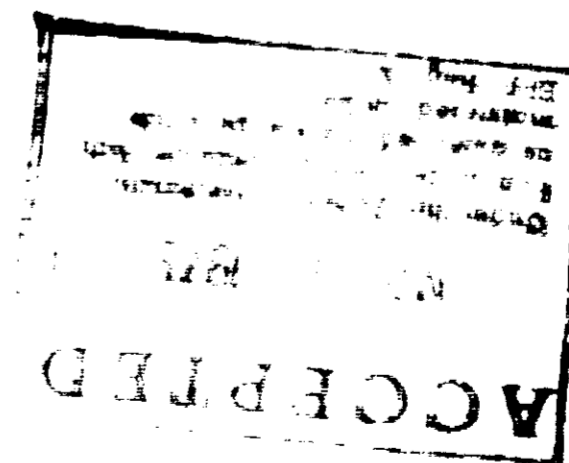

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on crops. Protective information may be obtained from your Cooperative Agricultural Extension Service.

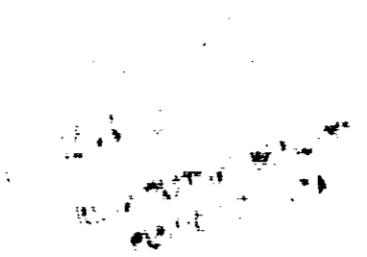
**DISPOSE OF WASTE:** by burying at least 18 inches deep in noncrop land away from water bodies. Empty cans should be treated with water. Do not burn.
