Copper Zinc 20-20 Spray is a material containing C-O-C-S® fungicide, a fixed copper; and Basic Zinc Sulphate for use as a spray in combating certain diseases and where an insoluble zinc is recommended for correction of zinc deficiency.

Mixing Directions

Fill the spray tank half full of water. Slowly sift in the required amount of Copper Zinc 20-20 Spray with the agitator running.

Directions for Application

Do not use this material on deciduous trees in foliage.

Apricots: Shot Hole Fungus—Apply 8 to 9 pounds Copper Zinc 20-20 Spray plus ½ to 1 gallon Dormant Flowable Oil Emulsion per 100 gallons of water. Apply as a dormant spray and in spring at red bud period. Observe the caution statement on the oil label prior to use.

Grapefruit, Lemons, Oranges: For prevention of Brown Rot—Use 1½ to 2 pounds per 100 gallons of water. Apply in the winter months. Spray the ground around the tree and the skirts of the trees to a height of 3 to 4 feet. Give particular attention to covering the fruit. Treat inside as well as outside, spraying trunks and skirts thoroughly (4 to 6 gallons per tree is usually adequate). Retreatment may be

necessary. Do not disturb soil after treatment. In areas where there is a history of severe copper damage, spray the skirts no more than 2 feet high.

Nectarines and Peaches: Peach Blight, Peach Leaf Curl—Apply 8 to 9 pounds Copper Zinc 20-20 Spray plus 1/2 to 1 gallon Dormant Flowable Oil Emulsion per 100 gallons of water. Apply as a dormant spray and in spring at bud swell. Observe the caution statements on the oil label prior to use.
