

### First Al

If swallowed, drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger or blunt object. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention.

#### Antidote

Note to Physician: Active ingredient is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Patient should be kept under observation for 48 hours. Atropine is antidotal. Give 4 mg, atropine sulfate intramuscularly or intravenously as soon as cyanosis is overcome. Repeat every 15 minutes until patient is fully atropinized. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine. Do not give morphine.



For Mite control only, the oil may be reduced to 2 qts. per 100 gals, of water. Do not apply more than 2000 gals of spray per acre. If additional applications are required, do not apply within 90 days of the preceding treatment. When using over 2 quarts of oil per 100 gals, of water do not apply within 30 days of harvest. If using 2 quarts of oil per 100 gals, the material may be applied on the day of harvest. On tangerines, do not apply more than two applications per season.

Lemons (Western States Only): Black Scale, Brown Soft Scale, California Red Scale, Purple Scale, Citrus Red Mite—Use 14 pt with 1 to 11: gals of summer type spray oil per 100 gals of water. Do not apply more than 2000 gals of spray per acre. Do not apply more than 1 application per season. Do not apply within 21 days of harvest.
