DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply when insects first appear. Do not use in undiluted form.

CITRUS (Sweet, Sour, and Grapefruit): Use 1 1/2 to 2 gallons of this material per 100 gallons of water for control of Yellow Scale, Citricola Scale, Red Scale, Soft Brown Scale and Citrus Red Mine.

ORANGE: Use 1 1/2 to 2 gallons of this material per 100 gallons of water for control of Olive Scale, Black Scale and Oleander Scale.

Special attention has been given in the formulation of Niagara Citrus Soluble Oil to make it compatible with wettable powder materials such as Niagara Phoskil 25 Spray, Niagara Dithion 25 Spray, and products used for the correction of minor element deficiencies.

MIXING DIRECTIONS

Before using this product, be sure the spray tank is clean and contains just enough water to cover the agitator shaft. If an injector is used, first add 25 to 50 gallons of water to start the agitator running to provide good pressure. Then put injector suction hose into the tank, add desired amount of spray oil, opening injector valve to allow the oil to be sucked into the tank. Then fill the tank with water. With enough water in tank to cover agitator shaft and with shaft in motion, add desired amount of this material for full tank. Pump this mixture through the overflow and back into tank for about two minutes to insure proper emulsification. Fill with water, adding other desired materials as tank is filling. Keep agitator running at all times. Sufficient agitation must be present to insure proper emulsification at all times. Keep agitator running at all times.

Plants should be sprayed only when in vigorous condition and when their moisture condition is suitable.

Do not make an oil spray application within 2 weeks prior to or after an application of sulfur. On Citrus do not make an oil application within 60 days prior to or after an application of Sulfur.

Rinse equipment and containers and DISPOSE OF WASTES by burying in non-crop land away from water supplies. Do not reuse empty containers. One and five gallon cans should be smashed and buried with wastes. Return empty drums to your pesticide supplier. Do not re-use.


