DIRECTIONS FOR USE

On the following crops apply this material when insects or disease first appear and repeat as necessary. For proper disease control the plants must be protected during weather favorable to disease development. New growth should be protected throughout the growing season. If additional applications are needed for disease control after the time limitations of this product, use a suitable fungicide. May be applied with airplane or ground application equipment. Do not plant root crops other than carrots, potatoes, sweet potatoes and sugar beets as follow-up crops. Observe days interval between last application and harvest indicated by number in () following the crop.

BEANS (4): Downy Mildew, Rust, Anthracnose, Black Bean Aphid, Bean Leaf Skeletonizer, Cucumber Beetles, Green Stink Bug, Mexican Bean Beetle — Use 25 pounds per acre. Do not make more than 3 applications per season. Do not feed treated threshings to livestock or allow to graze in treated fields. Do not use on lima beans that are to be removed from the field for processing.

BROCCOLI (7), CABBAGE (7), BRUSSELS SPROUTS (14), CAULIFLOWER (14): Downy Mildew, Alternaria Leaf Spot, Cabbage Aphid, Cabbage Looper, Cross-Stripped Cabbageworm, Diamondback Moth Larvae, Flea Beetles, Harlequin Bugs, Imported Cabbageworm, Stink Bug — Use 25 pounds per acre.

CARROTS (7): Leaf Blight, Cercospora Leaf Spot, Green Peach Aphid — Use 25 pounds per acre. Make no more than 2 applications. Do not use tops for food or feed.

CELERY (Whole Plant) (14): Early and Late Blight, Green Peach Aphid, Cabbage Looper — Use 25 pounds per acre. Make no more than 3 applications. Remove excess residues by washing, stripping and trimming.

CUCUMBERS (5), SQUASH (5): Aphids, Cucumber Beetles, Squash Vine Borer, Striped Cabbage Flea Beetle, Downy Mildew, Anthracnose — Use 25 pounds per acre. For Vine Borer control apply weekly to flower buds, stems and vines beginning when moths first appear.

LETTUCE (14): Downy Mildew, Cabbage Looper, Diamondback Moth Larvae, Green Peach Aphid, Imported Cabbageworm — Use 25 pounds per acre. On Head Lettuce do not make more than 3 applications after thinning. Do not feed crop refuse to livestock. Remove residues from Head Lettuce by stripping and trimming, and from Leaf Lettuce by washing or other effective means. On leaf lettuce do not make more than 2 applications per season.

MELONS (5): Downy Mildew, Anthracnose, Aphids, Cucumber Beetles, Striped Cabbage Flea Beetle, Omnivorous Leafroller, Cabbage Looper — Use 25 to 35 pounds per acre.

PEPPERS (1): Fruit Rot, Anthracnose, Green Peach Aphid, Flea Beetles, Hornworms, Pepper Maggot — Use 25 to 35 pounds per acre.

PUMPKINS (0): Downy Mildew, Angular Leaf Spot, Aphids, Cucumber Beetles, Squash Vine Borer — Use 25 pounds per acre. For Vine Borer control apply weekly to flower buds, stems and vines beginning when moths first appear.

TOMATOES (5): Early and Late Blight, Anthracnose, Septoria Leaf Spot, Cladosporium Gray Mold, Blister Beetle, Colorado Potato Beetle, Flea Beetles, Green Peach Aphid, Cabbage Looper, Stink Bugs, Tomato Fruitworm, Yellow-Striped Armyworm, Tomato Hornworm, Whitefly, Tomato Russet Mite — Use 25 pounds per acre. Do not apply where run-off is likely to occur.

SPINACH (21): Crown Mite, Green Peach Aphid and Downy Mildew — Use 18 pounds per acre. Do not make more than 1 application per season. Remove excess residues by washing.

USAGE CAUTIONS

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of lakes, ponds and streams. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on the label.

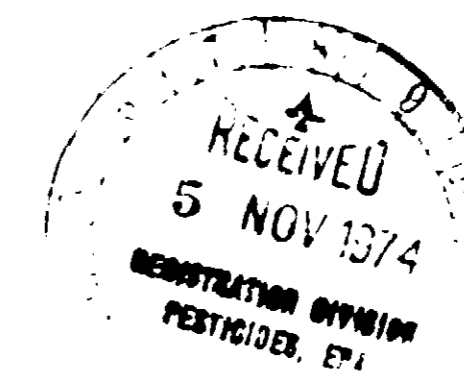
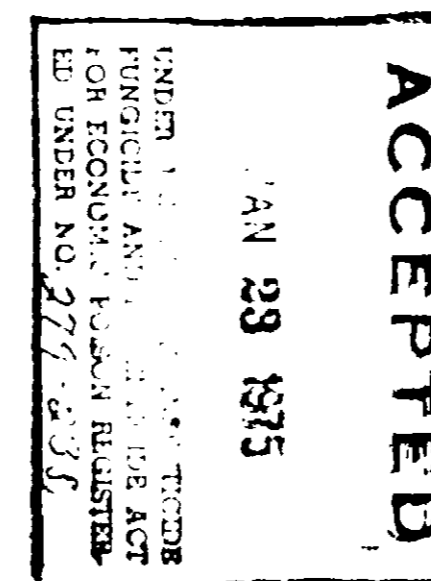
