# AZAK® 8 COATED GRANULES

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Niagara Azak 8 Coated Granules will control crabgrass when it is applied according to directions. It is nearly specific for crabgrass and has little or no effect on broad-leaved weeds. Crabgrass is an annual grass that starts from seed produced the previous year and germinates in the soil as soon as the weather is sufficiently warm. Azak 8 Coated Granules as a pre-emergence herbicide, both prevents germination of crabgrass seed and kills small seedlings after they have absorbed the chemical through their roots. Azak 8 Coated Granules will not control mature or well-established crabgrass. Azak 8 Coated Granules is recommended only for established lawn or other ornamental turf. It should not be applied to other crops or areas. Other grasses in established turf, such as quackgrass, annual bluegrass, or yellow foxtail, are not controlled.

At the recommended rate, grasses normally used in lawns, such as red fescue, bent, common Kentucky bluegrass, Merion bluegrass, St. Augustine, centipede, zoysia, hybrid and common Bermudas, and Dichondra, are tolerant. Rates in excess of the recommended dosage may cause discoloration or thinning, particularly of fescue. Discoloration of bent and bluegrass from slight over dosages usually disappears.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Early application before crabgrass germination is essential for successful control. Apply to established turf early in the spring before crabgrass seeds germinate. Turf margins along walks, driveways, and other similar areas are ideal for crabgrass germination and should be thoroughly treated.

Application should be made March 1 to May 15 depending upon geographic location and earliness of season. Apply uniformly over the entire area of established turf at the rate of 125 pounds per acre, or 3 pounds per 1000 square feet. Immediately after application, the treated area must be overhead sprinkled to incorporate the material into the soil.

Use only on established lawn or other ornamental turf. Azak 8 Coated Granules is only for use on lawn or other ornamental turf. DO NOT apply to other crops or areas.

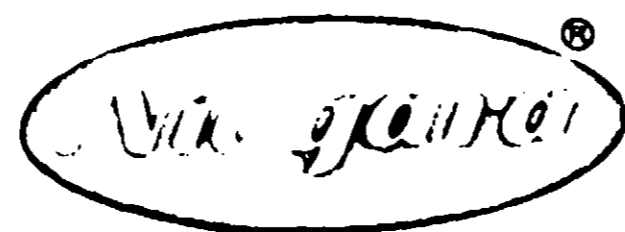
DO NOT use more than is recommended. Overdosage may cause discoloration or thinning of desirable grasses. Azak 8 Coated Granules should not be used in the spring on areas that are to be seeded before the next fall. DO NOT seed and apply simultaneously, or apply before new seedlings are well established. Thinning or discoloration may occur during prolonged dry spells if used on pure stands of bent or fescue. Bare areas which may occur in the turf due to crabgrass removal usually will fill in with adjacent turfgrasses under proper fertilization and turf management. If seeding of these areas should become necessary, DO NOT seed before fall following treatment in the spring.

Dispose of wastes by burying in non-crop land, or in areas free from vegetation, and water supplies. Empty containers should be buried with wastes. Do not reuse containers.

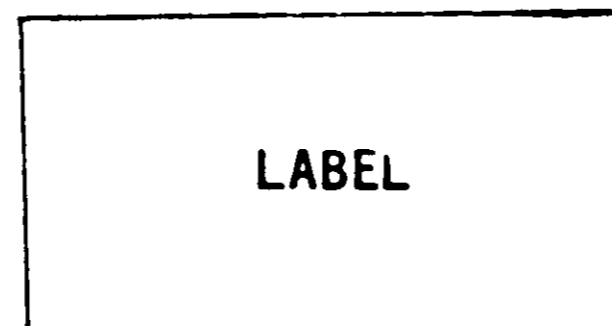
