DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For Powdery Mildew control apply when disease first appears and repeat as necessary. For other disease control see the directions below. May be applied by ground or air. Observe days interval between application and harvest as indicated by number in () following the crop.

BLACKBERRIES (7), BOYSENBERRIES (7), RASPBERRIES (7) (Pacific Northwest Only): Fruit Decay (Botrytis Rot) and Powdery Mildew — Use 50 pounds per acre. Use a maximum of 4 applications. Begin application just prior to bloom and continue at 7 day intervals.

GRAPES (1): Bunch Rot, Storage Rot (Botrytis Rot) and Powdery Mildew—Use 30 pounds per acre. For Bunch Rot and Storage Rot control, begin application while clusters are still loose and repeat applications at two week intervals. Ground application preferred.

HEAD LETTUCE (14): (Field) Wilt (Botrytis Rot, Scelerotinia) — Use 30 pounds per acre. Apply first application at thinning. Repeat application 7 days later.

LEAF LETTUCE (Greenhouse): Blight, (Botrytis Rot) — Use 30 pounds per acre. Apply dust 10 days following transplanting. Repeat applications when plants are half mature. Do not apply to wilted plants, seedlings or later than 14 days before harvest.

PEACHES, NECTARINES: Brown Rot, Blossom Blight, (Monilinia), and Powdery Mildew— Use 60 pounds per acre. Apply at pink bud and full bloom. Fruit decay (Monilinia), Brown Rot (Rhizopus) and Powdery Mildew— Use 60 pounds per acre. Apply 18 days, 10 days and 1 day prior to harvest.

SNAP BEANS (2): White Mold (Sclerotinia Sclerotiorum) and Powdery Mildew — Use 50 pounds per acre on pole varieties. On bush varieties use 37 pounds per acre. Begin applications when disease is anticipated and continue at 7 day intervals during periods favorable to development of disease. Do not feed treated forage to livestock. Sulphur may injure certain varieties; check tolerance to sulphur prior to application.

SWEET CHERRIES: Blossom Blight — Use 50 pounds per acre. Apply at Pop Corn, Bloom, Full Bloom and Petal Fall. Brown Rot, Fruit Decay (Monilinia), Rhizopus Rot (Rhizopus) — Use 50 pounds per acre. Apply 10 days and 1 day prior to harvest.


