Add this material to the tank while filling with water and with the agitator running. Agitate until the particles are thoroughly mixed before spraying.

Apply the following recommended rates in sufficient water to thoroughly cover one acre. (With ground application equipment on Almonds, Apricots and Prunes use a minimum of 250 gallons of water per acre.)

Usage Directions

Almonds and Prunes: Brown Rot, Leaf Blight, Blossom and Twig Blight—Use 3-4 pounds per 100 gallons of water or use 18 pounds per acre in a minimum of 250 gallons of water per acre. Applied to destroy spore sources. Apply after the spore mats appear on twigs, but before bud scales begin to separate as it may kill blossoms. In most locations this will be approximately mid-January. Do not apply after bud scales have begun to separate. Do not apply oil sprays within 3 weeks before or after applying this material. Do not use this material in combination with other spray chemicals. This treatment may damage cover crops.

Apricots: Brown Rot—Use 4 pounds per 100 gallons of water or use 16 pounds per acre in a minimum of 250 gallons of water per acre. Applied to destroy spore sources. Apply after the spore mats appear on twigs, but only when trees are fully dormant and before bud scales begin to separate as it may kill blossoms. In most locations this will be approximately mid-December to mid-January. When applying to open bud scale varieties of apricots, such as Moorpark and Hemekirk, do not apply until after buds swell, but before buds begin to separate. Do not apply oil sprays within 3 weeks before or after applying this material. Do not use this material in combination with other spray chemicals. This treatment may damage cover crops.
