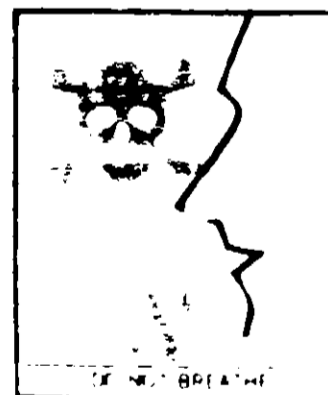
POISONOUS IF SWALLOWED

The poison will kill you if swallowed. Even small amounts of spray mist or dust may be fatal if swallowed.



POISONOUS BY SKIN CONTACT

Persons who touch your hands or skin after spraying should wash their hands and clothing with soap and water.



POISONOUS IF BREATHED

Do not breathe spray or dust. It may be fatal.

POISONOUS TO FISH AND WILDLIFE

Do not spray on water. Do not spray on land where birds, fish, or other wildlife may be present. Do not spray on water. Do not spray on land where birds, fish, or other wildlife may be present.

NOT FOR HOME USE

USE ONLY WHEN WEARING THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT AND CLOTHING

1. Wear water proof pants, coat, hat, rubber boots or rubber overshoes.
2. Wear safety goggles.
3. Wear mask or respirator approved by the U.S. Bureau of Mines for parathion protection.
4. Wear heavy duty natural rubber gloves.

WORK SAFETY RULES

Keep all unprotected persons and children away from treated area or where there is danger of drift.

Do not rub eyes or mouth with hands. If you feel sick in any way STOP work and get help right away. Call a doctor, physician, clinic or hospital immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to parathion and describe his condition. After first aid is given, see First Aid Treatment Section and if a doctor cannot come, take victim to clinic or hospital.

IMPORTANT! Before removing gloves wash them with soap and water. Always wash hands, face and arms with soap and water before smoking, eating or drinking.

AFTER WORK take off all work clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Wear only clean clothes when leaving job. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and protective equipment with soap and water after each use. Respirator should be cleaned and filter replaced according to instructions included with respirator.

PARATHION is a very dangerous poison that rapidly enters the body on contact with all skin surfaces and eyes. Clothing wet with this material must be removed immediately. Exposed persons must receive prompt medical treatment or they may die.

Some of the signs and symptoms of poisoning are: headache, nausea, vomiting, cramps, weakness, blurred vision, pinpoint pupils, tightness in chest, labored breathing, dizziness, sweating, watering of eyes, drooling, frothing at mouth and nose, muscle spasms, etc.

FIRST AID TREATMENT

Call a doctor, physician, clinic or hospital immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to parathion and describe his condition.

If breathing has stopped, give artificial respiration. If necessary, use mouth-to-mouth respiration.

If swallowed and victim is awake, induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat or by giving strong or strong salty water to drink. Repeat until vomit is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Have victim lie down and keep quiet. See doctor immediately.

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. See doctor immediately.

The signs and symptoms of poisoning are: dizziness, headache, nausea, vomiting, cramps, weakness, blurred vision, pin-point pupils, tightness in chest, slow and irregular breathing, nervousness, sweating, drooping of eyelids, drooling or frothing of mouth, muscle spasms and coma.

FIRST AID TREATMENT

Call physician, clinic or hospital immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to parathion and describe his condition.

Respiration has stopped, start artificial respiration immediately.

Unconscious and victim is awake, conscious, vomit quickly. Induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat or by giving strong salty water to drink. Repeat until vomit is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Have victim lie down and rest. See doctor immediately.

In case of eye contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Remove clothing and shoes immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Since any symptoms from absorption of this combination product are like to be those of parathion intoxication, treatment should be directed towards the relief of cholinesterase inhibition.

Antidote—administer atropine sulfate in large doses, TWO to FOUR mg. intravenously or intramuscularly as soon as cyanosis is overcome. Repeat at 5 to 10 minute intervals until signs of atropinization appear. 2-PAM chloride is also available and may be administered in conjunction with atropine. DO NOT GIVE MORPHINE OR TRANQUILIZERS. Parathion is a strong cholinesterase inhibitor affecting the central and peripheral nervous systems and producing cardiac and respiratory depression. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be given supplemental oxygen and treated symptomatically. Continued absorption of the poison may occur and fatal relapses have been reported after initial improvement. VERY CLOSE SUPERVISION OF THE PATIENT IS INDICATED FOR AT LEAST 48 HOURS.
