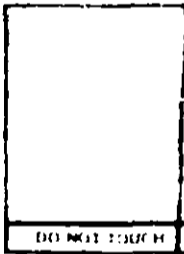


**POISONOUS IF SWALLOWED**

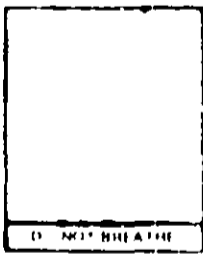

## FIRST AID TREATMENT
