DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FIELD CORN (At Planting Time): To control Northern, Southern and Western Corn Rootworm use 7½ to 10 pounds of Furadan 10 Granules, in a 7 inch band, per 13,000 linear feet of row or on an acre basis using 40-inch row spacing. Incorporate into the top 1 inch of soil by making application ahead of press wheels, or by use of special covering devices, or by dragging a short length of chain behind the press wheels. This treatment will also aid in the control of first generation European Corn Borer and it will reduce losses due to Stalk Rot by reducing the incidence of insect wounds which permit entry by the stalk rot fungi.

- OR -

FIELD CORN (Post Plant Treatment): To control Northern and Western Corn Rootworm use 7½ to 10 pounds of Furadan 10 Granules per 13,000 linear feet (equivalent to 1 acre with 40-inch row spacings). Apply by banding over the row and cultivating into the soil or by side dressing on both sides of the row.

*Do not make more than one application per season.

APPLICATOR INDICATOR SETTING

Furadan 10 Granules is a dense, free-flowing product which will require application equipment to be calibrated to apply the recommended amount per acre. The following are approximate settings for guidance in calibration.
