DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply when pests first appear and repeat as required. May be applied with airplane or ground application equipment.

LETTUCE: Aphids, Armyworms, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, Armyworm, Imported Cabbageworm Climbing Cutworms, Grasshoppers, Field Crickets — Use 30 pounds per acre. Do not apply after seedling stage on leaf lettuce. Do not apply after heads begin to form on head lettuce.

BROCCOLI, BRUSSELS SPROUTS, CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER: Aphids, Armyworms, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers. Corn Earworm, Imported Cabbageworm, Diamondback Moth, Fall Armyworm, Climbing Cutworms - Use 25 pounds per acre. On Cabbage do not apply after heads start to form. 
