Uniformly mix the proper amount of Polyram 53.5% Seed Treater with seed.

### Drill Box Treatment Method

1. When the drill box is empty at the start of the seedling operations, mix some seed with the required amount of Polyram 53.5% Seed Treater in a separate container and place this treated seed in the bottom of the empty box.
