## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

NOT FOR USE OR STORAGE IN OR AROUND THE HOME.

TOBACCO: Blue Mold, Aphids, Flea Beetle, Stink Bugs - FIELD: Use 16 to 20 pounds of dust per acre. Good coverage is essential. Repeat as needed. Do not apply this material to tobacco within 5 days of priming or 15 days of cutting. Do not allow plant juices to come in contact with the skin or other parts of the body when cutting the crop. Gloves should be worn in transferring the plants or harvesting leaf if an application has been made within 30 days. Avoid the use of this material during flowering and pollination periods.

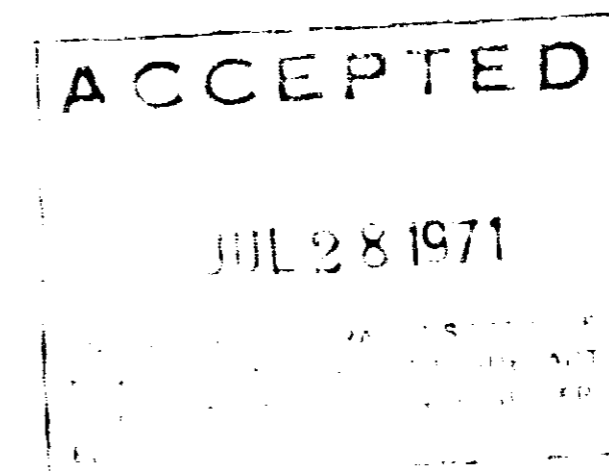

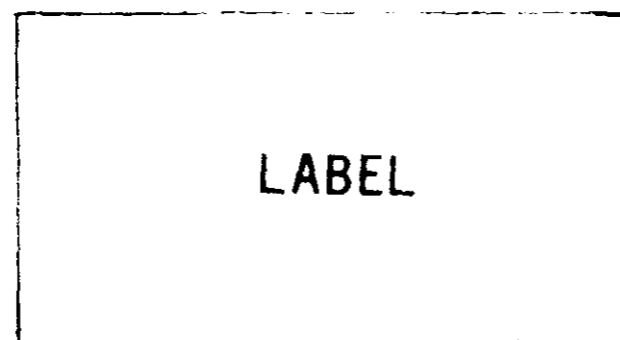
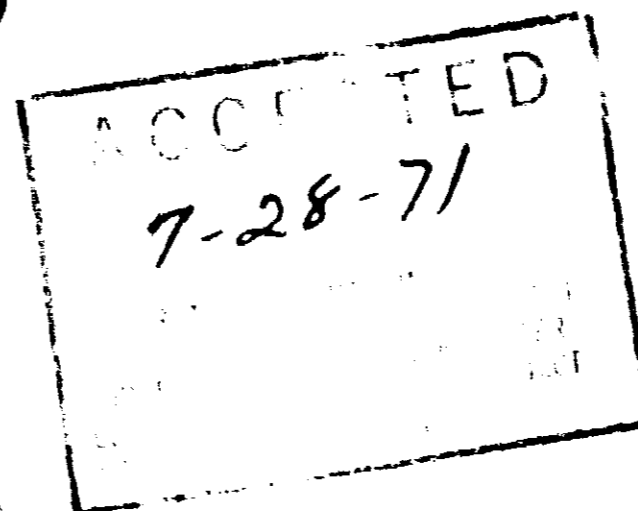
