DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TOBACCO: Antiracnose, blue mold, cabbage looper, green peach aphid, tobacco budworm, tobacco flea beetle, tobacco hornworm, stink bugs - **FIELD USE:** Apply 20 to 25 pounds per acre. Good coverage is essential. Make first application as soon as plants are set in field. Repeat as needed. Do not apply this material within 5 days of priming or 15 days of cutting. Avoid the use of this material during flowering and pollination.

DANGER: Do not allow plant juices to come in contact with skin or other parts of the body of those engaged in cutting crop. Workers entering treated areas within 24 hours of treatment should wear protective clothing.

USAGE CAUTIONS

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of any body of water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from the areas treated. Do not apply when runoff is likely to occur. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on crops. For protective information may be obtained from your Cooperative Agricultural Extension Service.

Dispose of wastes by burying at least 6 inches beneath ground away from water supplies. Do not re-use container for any other purpose.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed: Give one teaspoon of table salt in a glass of warm water. Repeat until vomiting occurs and vomitus is clear. Never induce vomiting in an unconscious person. Call a physician immediately.

If In Eyes: Flush eyes for 15 minutes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

If On Skin or Clothing: Remove contaminated clothing and shoes immediately. Bathe with soap and water. Call a physician immediately.

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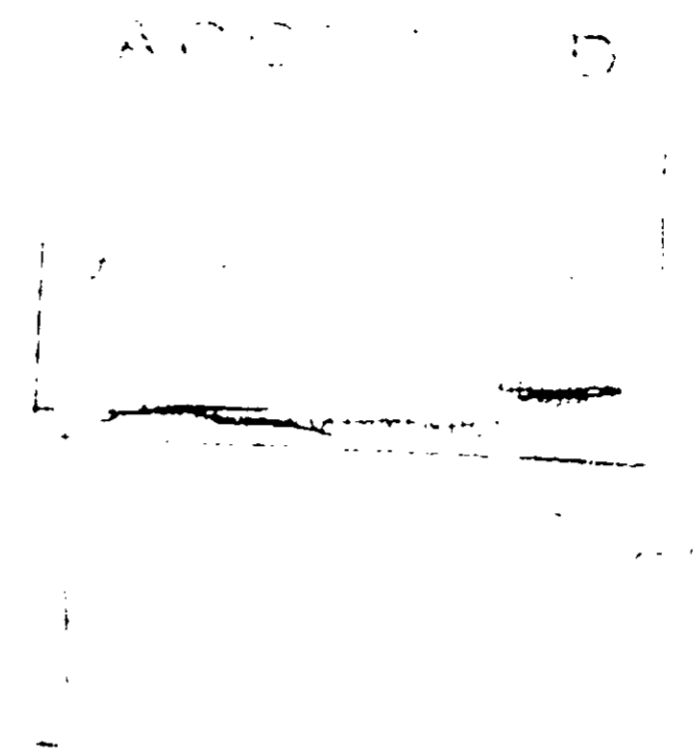
ANTIDOTE

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Methyl Parathion is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Patient should be kept under observation for 48 hours. Atropine is antidotal. Give 4 mg. intramuscularly or intravenously. Repeat every 15 minutes until patient is fully atropinized. If cyanotic give artificial respiration. Pralidoxime chloride (2-PAM) should be used in treatment. For additional assistance call (716) 735-3761; Endosulfan is a central nervous system stimulant and may cause convulsions. There is no specific antidote. Barbituric acid derivatives may be used in treatment.

DANGER: POISONOUS If Swallowed, Inhaled or Absorbed Through Skin! Rapidly Absorbed Through Skin! Avoid breathing dust. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles. In case of contact wash immediately with soap and water. Wear a mask or respirator passed by the U.S. Department of Agriculture for Methyl Parathion-Thiodan mixtures. Keep all unprotected persons out of operating areas or vicinity where there may be danger of drift. Vacated areas should not be re-entered until drifting insecticide and volatile residues have dissipated. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and water before reuse.

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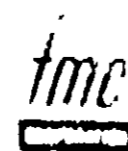
