Niagara Dursban® 1 Coated Granules are especially prepared coated granules containing 1% Dursban for use as a Mosquito Larvicide only by Mosquito Abatement Districts and other Official Agencies. These granules are formulated to release their coating upon contact with water.

For the control of mosquito larvae on non-crop flooded areas use 2 1/2 to 5 lbs. per acre. As a pre-hatch treatment on areas not presently covered by water, apply 10 pounds per acre.

RESTRICTIONS

Do not use inside homes, in dairy barns, poultry houses or buildings where food is processed.

Do not use on crops used for food or forage.

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Shrimp and crab may be killed at application rates recommended on this label. Do not apply where these are important resources. 
