GENERAL INFORMATION

Acaralate 2 EC miticide is an emulsifiable solution intended for use in mixing sprays, which when applied as directed will control European Red Mites and Two-Spotted Spider Mites on apples and pears. Thorough coverage of trees is essential for effective control. Either dilute or concentrate spray equipment can be used, providing the spray reaches all parts of the tree, especially the under-sides of the leaves. The mixing rates listed below are offered as a guide for preparing dilute, high-gallonage sprays. The suggested rates should be adjusted accordingly for application with concentrate sprayers.

Acaralate 2 EC should be applied in pre-bloom sprays or when mite infestations first appear. Severe mite infestations will require repeated applications, properly timed to coincide with mite build-up.

COMPATIBILITY

Acaralate is physically compatible with many of the commonly used insecticides and fungicides such as captan WP; Diazinon EC, WP; Guthion EC, WP; lead arsenate WP; Sevin WP; and zineb WP. Acaralate has been found to be incompatible with dodine (Cypres) product, urea, Dyrene WP, sulfur, tribasic copper sulfate and dichlorone (Phygon XL). When Acaralate is to be combined with other spray materials the physical compatibility of the mixture should be evaluated by premixing the materials in small quantities.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

APPLES and PEARS - Two-Spotted Spider Mite and European Red Mites: Apply 1 1/2 - 2 pts. per 100 gals. of dilute spray in prebloom or cover sprays or whenever infestations first appear. Repeat applications as needed. In areas where severe mite infestations occur, make two applications of 2 pts. per 100 gals. of dilute spray 14 days apart.

Do not apply to apples or pears within 14 days of harvest. Do not apply in combination with spray oil or oil emulsion. In western states, to avoid injury to fruit, do not apply with hand gun. Do not graze treated areas.
