### Environmental Cautions

Protective clothing means, at least, a hat or other suitable head covering, a long sleeved shirt and long legged trousers or a coverall type garment (all of closely woven fabric covering the body, including the arms and legs), shoes and socks.

Because certain states may require specific reentry intervals for various crops treated with this product, consult your State Department of Agriculture for information.

### Storage and Disposal

#### Pesticide Storage

**Broccoli, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Collards, Kale, Mustard Greens, Turnip Greens:** Cabbage Looper and Imported Cabbageworm—Apply 25 to 40 pounds per acre.

**Lettuce:** Cabbage Looper—Apply 25 to 40 pounds per acre.
