CROP

PESTS TO BE CONTROLLED

Celery

Aphids, Serpentine leafminer, Early blight, Late blight

Apply 20 pounds per acre beginning when plants are set and repeat at 5 to 7 day intervals. Do not apply within 21 days of harvest. Remove residue by washing and stripping.

Tomatoes

Aphids, Serpentine leafminer, Tomato hornworm, Stinkbug, Leaf-footed plant bug, Flower thrips, Early blight, Late blight, Gray leafspot.

Apply at the rate of 20 pounds per acre. Make first application when plants become established in the field and repeat at 4 to 7 day intervals. Do not apply within 10 days of harvest.*

Aphids, Melonworm, Pickleworm, Serpentine leafminer, Squash bug, Downy mildew, Anthracnose

Begin application when plants start to vine and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervalsusing 20 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 15 days of harvest on cucumbers and squash*; do not apply within 7 days of harvest on melons and cantaloupes. WARNING: Do not apply to cucurbits before plants statt to vine or unless plants are dry.
