TANDEX 0.5 EC is an effective general herbicide for the control of many annual and perennial weeds, grasses, brush and trees. Apply to non-crop land areas, e.g. lumberyards, storage areas, around farm barns, fence rows and buildings, railroad and pipeline rights-of-way, and petroleum tank farms. The degree of control and duration of effect will vary with the amount of chemical applied, soil type, rainfall and other conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply TANDEX 0.5 EC before or during the period of active weed or brush growth. Partial or complete top kill may occur until sufficient moisture from rainfall or artificial means has carried the chemical into the root zone.
