Proposed New Use

CROP	TO CONTROL	REMARKS
Almond	Peach Twig Borer	For control of early season infestation use $2\frac{1}{2}$ to $3\frac{1}{3}$ quarts of Thiodan 3 EC in sufficient water to treat one acre. Apply during popcorn, pink or petal fall. Use a minimum of 200 gallons per acre dilute or 40 gallons per acre concentrate. For areas less than one acre, use one quart of Thiodan 3 EC per 100 gallons. Do not make more than one application per season

Notes:

- 1) -A tolerance for Thiodan (endosulfan) on almond and almond hulls was announced March 27, 1973 in the Federal Register.
- 2) Thiodan 2 C.O.E.C., 279-2659, Thiodan Miscible, 279-1182 and Thiodan 50 WP, 279-1380 were approved for control of peach twig borer, December 11, 1973.
- 3) Attached is the report of an animal acceptance study conducted with Thiodan treated almond hulls at label dosage rates as requested in the December 11, 1973 letter from Mr. Charles L. Smith.

Proposed New Use

CROP	TO CONTROL	REMARKS
Barley Oats Rye Wheat	Cereal Leaf Beetle	For use in Illinois, Indiana, Michigan and Ohio only. Use 2/3 to 1 1/3 pints per acre. Apply when small larvae are readily found in the field. For aerial application use a minimum of 1 to 2 gallons of water per acre. Do not apply after heads begin to form. Do not feed treated forage to live-stock.

Notes:

- 1) A tolerance for Thiodan (endosulfan) was established on barley, oats, rye and wheat on March 9, 1972 - (Federal Register, 37:47-5027).
- 2) Thiodan Miscible, EPA Reg. No. 279-1182, is registered for use on barley, oats, rye and wheat in Illinois, Indiana, Michigan and Ohio to control cereal leaf beetle.
