DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Niagara Diazinon Spectrum 415 is a prepackaged product containing Diazinon plus Niagara Spectrum 415 Spray Oil. This product should be used for dormant applications to fruit and nut crops in the Western States. When applied as directed, Niagara Diazinon Spectrum 415 Oil is an effective treatment against most of the overwintering insects and mite eggs. Make a dormant spray as soon as possible, but not before there has been enough rain to replenish soil moisture and to soak the trees so the bark is noticeably moist. Mix Niagara Diazinon Spectrum 415 Oil with water at the rates given below and apply as a dilute dormant or concentrate spray. When concentrate sprays are used, increase the concentration of Niagara Diazinon Spectrum 415 Oil in the spray mixtures so that the amount of Niagara Diazinon Spectrum 415 Oil per acre will be equivalent to the dilute spray (400 to 600 gallons per acre). As a concentrate spray, apply a minimum of 40 gallons per acre.

ALMONDS: To control Parlatoria, San Jose Scales and Peach Twig Borer (California Only) mix 1 1/2 to 2 1/4 gallons per 100 gallons of water.

APRICOTS: To control Apricot Mealybugs, Brown Apricot, San Jose, and Walnut Scales mix 1 1/2 gallons per 100 gallons of water.

APPLES: To control San Jose Scales, Mealybugs, Apple Aphid, European Red Mite and Brown Mite Eggs mix 1 1/2 gallons per 100 gallons of water.

CHERRIES: To control Black, Brown Apricot and San Jose Scales, Black Cherry Aphid and Brown Mite Eggs mix 2 1/4 gallons per 100 gallons of water and apply as a postharvest treatment only.

PEACHES and NECTARINES: To control Brown Apricot, San Jose and Walnut Scales, Peach Twig Borer (California Only) and Apricot Mealybugs mix 1 1/2 gallons per 100 gallons of water. Do not permit workers to re-enter treated area to engage in any activity requiring substantial contact with treated foliage within 5 days of application.

PEARS: To control Pear Leaf Blister, Mites, Mealybugs, Brown Apricot and San Jose Scales mix 1 1/2 gallons per 100 gallons of water.

PLUMS and PRUNES: To control Peach Twig Borer, Mealy Plum Aphid, Eggs, Parlatoria and San Jose Scales and Brown Almond Mites mix 1 1/2 gallons per 100 gallons of water.

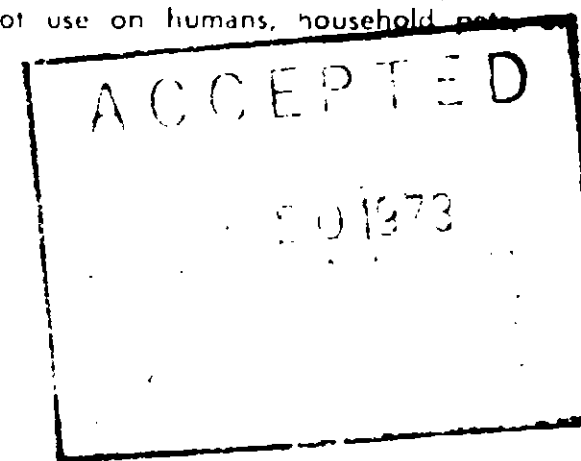
