The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

In the original Notice of Pesticide Registration expiration dates associated with conditional registration were applied to both end use and manufacturing use products. Since a manufacturing use product can be formulated into many end-use products some of which may not be subject to any conditions of registration it is inappropriate to assign an expiration date to a manufacturing use product. Should the Agency implement cancellation action against use(s) of a pesticide then the manufacturing use registrant(s) would be required to delete such use(s) from the manufacturing use label. Thus the Agency will no longer impose an expiration date or specific conditions of registration for the subject manufacturing use product.

Note that manufacturing use products are subject to the labeling revisions indicated in PR Notice 91-8.
